New schools, modernizations and modular classrooms are prioritized and requested by the CBE but funded by the provincial government.


The public and Trustees have requested a review of ranking criteria for prioritizing new school and major modernization requests.



#### **Current Considerations?**

- Role of the school and accommodation plans (Score x30)
  - Strength of the school role into the future
- Enrolment, utilization and enrolment projections (Score x 25)
  - Strength of enrolment and utilization into the future
- Site features and location (Score x 5)
  - Quality of site features in terms of size and access.
     Quality of location to serve students. (E.g. space for bus and parent drop-off, number of street frontages)
- Ability to upgrade the facility (Score x 20)
  - Ability to upgrade in terms of teaching environment and costs

5 = Excellent

4 = Very Good

3 = Good

2 = Fair

1= Poor

- Facility condition (Score x 20)
  - Quality of the facility

1 = Excellent

2 = Very Good

3 = Good

4 = Fair

5= Poor



#### **Accommodation Considerations**

- Projected Enrolment
  - Will modular classrooms solve the issue in the long-term
- Availability of other accommodation options in close proximity

## Current practice for assessing suitability of modular classrooms

- Site review and considerations
- Building code and City bylaw considerations

#### **Construction Phase**

- Scope of work for modular additions
- Scope of work for modular relocations

Costs – based on new Modus Modulars

Site conditions can add a wide variance to project costs

Timelines – commencing from provincial approval
