Is Arts-Centred Learning the Right Choice for My Child?

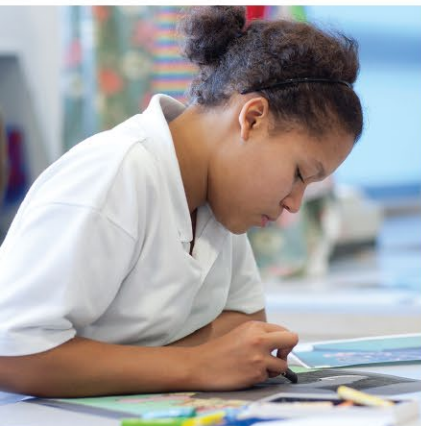


A successful student demonstrates:

- the ability to engage in a program grounded in the arts connected to core curriculum through project-based learning
- the ability to work well in a variety of situations; collaboratively and independently

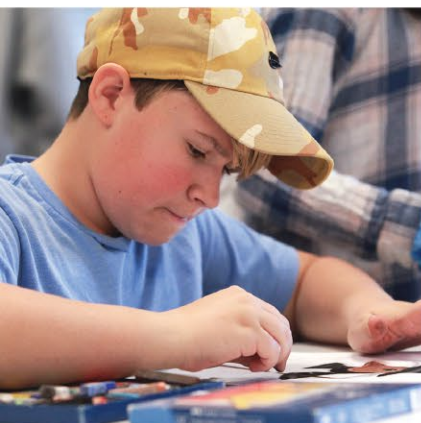
Characteristics of the Arts-Centred Program

- Arts-focused inquiry integrating Alberta Education's curriculum
- Develop creative and critical thinking
- An understanding of the lived experiences of artists
- Learning comes from the process as well as the product
- A sense of belonging in an active community within and beyond the school
- Students represent their knowledge and understanding through the multiple perspectives found throughout the arts
- Students learn to share, appreciation of the arts as an integral component of culture and community
- Skill development in the arts is integrated throughout the curriculum connecting with artists in both the school and community
