FAST FACTS

- On an average school day in Alberta, over 300,000 students are transported by school buses
- oThe color of yellow used on school buses is ACTUALLY called 'National School Bus Glossy Yellow'



OUR EXPECTATIONS OF PARENTS

- •Register your child for bus transportation (not the same as registration for school)
- Ensure child carry basic information in their backpack like name, school and contact information
- Attend My 1st Ride program
- Respect rules of bus and the bus driver
- ODo not discuss issues or concerns with driver contact the bus company or school board staff

OUR EXPECTATIONS OF PARENTS

- oParents are not allowed to board the school bus
- oParents MUST know bus route letter or number, stop location and name of school their child attends. This information is available on school district and school websites
- ODriver's primary concern is the safe transportation of all children. Please support the driver in student management issues
- oParents will not park in the bus zone at a stop or at school, and will follow all traffic safety laws and parking bylaws

PARENT/CAREGIVER RESPONSIBILITIES

- OYour child's safety to and from and at the stop location is a parental responsibility. Ensure your child has dressed appropriately for the weather
 - o If you choose to let your child walk alone, this is a parental decision and the responsibility is yours
- •Practice walking to and from the stop location
- oFollow all traffic safety rules and only cross streets at intersections, when safe to do so
- Only use the designated stop location provided to you
- OBe at the stop 5 minutes before the listed departure time
- oGet to know your neighborhood and have an emergency back-up plan in place
- olf you plan on meeting your child at the stop location, teach them what to do if you are NOT there or they miss their stop

PARENT/CAREGIVER RESPONSIBILITIES

PARENT ROUTE INQUIRES

- Drivers are not permitted to make route changes
- oParents must complete and submit a bus stop change request following your school board's change request process



PARENT RESPONSIBILITY: KINDERGARTEN

- oKindergarten students must be aware they need to stay on the bus unless a responsible person that the student recognizes is at the door of the bus to meet them
- •Kindergarten students must tell the driver if a parent or responsible caregiver is not at the bus doors

SCHOOL RESPONSIBILITIES

- Providing supervision for school bus loading and unloading and directing students onto the right bus
- oldentifying kindergarten students to driver
- Directing students to sit in the bus seating plan

SCHOOL BOARD RESPONSIBILITIES

- Creating and changing bus routes
- Selecting safe stop locations
- Ensuring communication between bus company, school and parents





BUS COMPANY RESPONSIBILITIES

To provide:

- Safe and reliable transportation
- •Well-trained staff
- Maintain late service information on applicable communication platforms
 - Southland Transportation: My School Bus Monitor website (<u>myschoolbusmonitor.ca</u>)and MyBusStop App (<u>https://www.mybusstop.ca</u>)
 - o First Student: FirstView App (https://web.firstviewapp.com) or Bus Status website (https://firststudentcalgary.busstatus.ca)

BUS DRIVERS DO NOT

- Have student contact information
- Use cell phones while working
- Provide their personal phone numbers
- Make unauthorized stops
- Allow parents or other unauthorized persons to board the bus
- Administer medication



THINGS YOU NEED TO KNOW!



LATE BUS | WHAT TO DO

- Students should not be left at the stop alone
- Have a plan if you cannot pick up your child and share it with your family or other caregivers
- olf there is no obvious reason for delay and you have waited 15 minutes or more, contact the bus company
- Parents continue to be responsible until their child boards the bus

CAUSES FOR BUS DELAYS

- Weather and road conditions
- Road construction/repairs
- Traffic delays
- Dual routing delays
- Driver absenteeism
- •Mechanical problems
- Bus driver shortage

MISSING CAREGIVER

Students must tell driver there is no one there to meet them:

- OParents, reinforce with your child to stay on the bus
- oRemember: If you choose to let your child walk to and from home unsupervised, that is your decision and responsibility is yours
- Child should have contact phone numbers and address in their backpack or jacket
- Bus company will attempt to contact parent or guardian while driver completes route

MISSING STUDENT

If the bus arrives at the stop and the caregiver informs driver that a student is missing:

- Driver contacts Dispatch
- ODispatch calls school and radio's out to other drivers from the same school
- Often a spouse/partner already picked student up at school

The student may have boarded the wrong bus or is still at school:

- ONOT all schools take attendance. Check with your school to determine the current protocol.
- olf the student is not located, parents are encouraged to contact the police

MISSING ITEMS

- OBus companies are not responsible for items left on the bus
- •Check with the driver on the following trip to see if your item was found
- oLost and found items are normally returned to the school, not to the bus company

NON-TRANSPORTABLE ITEMS

For student safety and allergy reasons, some items are not transported according to Alberta Transportation:

- Animals (exceptions for Registered Service Animals)
- Unsecured items
- Large school projects, band instruments, skateboards, hockey sticks, etc.
- oFor a complete list of restricted items on all school buses refer to the school board transportation website.
