- Both programs are externally validated through the writing of internationally recognized examinations
- Both programs are recognized by admission officers as being advanced and give the students an edge in being accepted into competitive universities
- Both programs give students access to scholarships
- Both programs provide opportunities for students to receive credit for the successful completion of advanced courses; thus allowing students to complete requirements for a degree in less time
- AP is recognized by leading American and Canadian Universities as an enhanced program; the IB program is recognized primarily in Canada and Europe
