IB is a rigorous academic program which emphasizes the ideals of international understanding and responsible citizenship and may provide advanced university credit.

A student is designated to an IB Programme based on the Area in which they reside. Students are to apply to the IB School in their Area.

When admitted to Grade 10 at John G. Diefenbaker, the student is a Preparation for IB candidate who must be successful in the enrichment materials and activities included in that year in order to qualify as an IB student in grades 11 and 12.

Applicants have two candidacy options:

1. The **IB Diploma** requires students carry a full program of IB courses. Students applying for this option are given priority in the application process.
2. The **IB Certificate Program** is for those students who wish to combine part of the IB Programme with the regular Alberta Education curriculum. Certificate students are required to take a minimum of two IB courses. A student receives a certificate for each IB course successfully completed.

Please complete this application prior to the IB application deadline. A copy of the application form and an application checklist is included with this package. Ensure the checklist is reviewed to confirm completion of all applicable sections.

The deadline for junior high schools to submit completed applications to John G. Diefenbaker High School is Friday, January 13, 2012.

Part I. RESIDENCY DECLARATION FOR COMPLETION BY PARENT(S)/LEGAL GUARDIAN(S)

It is important to determine the residency of a student to determine the admission priority for the student if there is not sufficient room in the IB program at John G. Diefenbaker High School.

A student is determined to be a resident or non-resident of the Calgary Board of Education based on two criteria:

Geography: Where the student's parent(s) or legal guardian(s) reside
Religion: The faith of the parent(s) of the student

Who is Resident to the Calgary Board of Education?

1. Geography – the parent(s)/legal guardian(s) who have day-to-day care of the student must live within the City of Calgary. In the case of an independent student, the student must live within the City of Calgary.
2. Religion – one or both parents who have day to day care of the student are not Roman Catholic. When both parents have day-to-day care and custody of a student and one is Roman Catholic and one is not, the parents may declare residency to the Calgary Board of Education by checking the appropriate box and signing the declaration below.

Who is Not Resident to the Calgary Board of Education?

1. Geography – the parent(s)/legal guardians(s) who have day to day care of the student live outside of the City of Calgary. In the case of an independent student, the student lives outside of the City of Calgary.
2. Religion – both parents are Roman Catholic.

Authority

The Alberta School Act 44(4) states:

"Where a separate school district is established, an individual residing within the boundaries of the separate school district who is of the same faith as those who established that district, whether Protestant or Roman Catholic,

(a) is a resident of the separate school district, and

(b) is not a resident of the public school district.
