Dear Parents/Guardians,

Re: School Designation Change for Kindergarten to Grade 9 Regular Program Students Residing in the Residential District of Copperfield

The Calgary Board of Education would like to inform parents that effective August 2009 there will be a change of school designation for kindergarten to grade 9 students living in Copperfield. These students are currently designated to Acadia School (kindergarten to grade 4) and David Thompson School (grade 5-grade 9) for the regular program.

Effective August 2009, kindergarten to grade 4 students living in Copperfield will be designated to Maple Ridge School for the regular program. Maple Ridge School is located at 10203 Maplemont Road S.E. (phone 403-777-6280), which is in the community of Maple Ridge.

Subsidized transportation services to Acadia School from the Copperfield community will continue to be provided until June 30, 2012 provided there are a minimum of 15 students. This will allow students who are currently in grade 1 at Acadia School to complete grade 4 at Acadia School.

Effective August 2009, grade 5 to grade 9 students living in Copperfield will be designated to R.T. Alderman School for the regular program. R.T. Alderman School is located at 725 Mapleton Drive S.E. (phone 403-777-7520), which is in the community of Maple Ridge.

Subsidized transportation services to David Thompson School from the Copperfield community will continue to be provided until June 30, 2013 provided there are a minimum of 15 students. This will allow students who are currently in grade 5 at David Thompson School to complete grade 9 at David Thompson School.


