Dear Parents/Guardians,

Re: School Designation for Regular Program Junior High Students Residing in the Martindale Community

Crossing Park School is the designated school for kindergarten to grade 9 students residing in the residential district of Martindale. Due to steady enrolment growth from the community all students cannot be accommodated at Crossing Park School at this time. Terry Fox School and Dr. Gordon Higgins School are the designated schools for junior high students who cannot be accommodated at Crossing Park School.

The boundary in the Martindale community that was created in March 2007, as part of the accommodation plan for kindergarten to grade 6 students will now also apply to students in grades 7 to 9. A map showing the boundary is included with this notice.

Students will continue to be recalled to Crossing Park School as space becomes available. Any new students in grades 7 to 9 are asked to register at Crossing Park School in order to ensure an accurate list of students who cannot be accommodated at Crossing Park School at this time.

For the 2009-2010 school year students are designated as follows:


- There is no change for students residing in Martindale attending Crossing Park School. These students continue to be designated to Crossing Park School for grades 7 to 9.
- There is no change for students residing in Martindale currently attending Terry Fox School; they remain designated to Terry Fox School.
- Students in grade 6 at Grant MacEwan School are designated to Terry Fox School regardless of where they reside in Martindale.
- Students in grade 6 at Rundle School are designated to Dr. Gordon Higgins School regardless of where they reside in Martindale.
- Any new* students in grades 7, 8 or 9 who reside outside of the established attendance area for Crossing Park School and in the south-east corner of the Martindale community are designated to Terry Fox School.
- Any new* students in grades 7, 8 or 9 who reside outside of the established attendance area for Crossing Park School and in the north-east corner of the Martindale community are designated to Dr. Gordon Higgins School.

- Any new* students in grades 7, 8 or 9 who reside inside the established attendance area for Crossing Park School and who are unable to attend Crossing Park School due to lack of space are designated to Dr. Gordon Higgins School.

*In this case, new students include students moving into the community as well as students who have attended other CBE schools and are now returning to their designated regular program school.


As is Calgary Board of Education practice, transportation services to Dr. Gordon Higgins School and Terry Fox School will be provided by regular Calgary Transit routes for students who live beyond 2.4 kilometers from their designated school. Eligible students may apply to the Calgary Board of Education for a partial rebate on the cost of a monthly Calgary Transit bus pass.
