Re: Regular Program School Designations for Students Residing in Tuscany

Student enrolment from the Tuscany community continues to grow and, as promised at the parent council meeting on October 8, 2008, members of the Community Engagement and Operational Planning team, Margaret McBride, Director of Area I and Bev Whitworth, Principal of Tuscany School, have met to review kindergarten registration and enrolment projections for the next school year.

As a result of this review, the Calgary Board of Education would like to inform parents that kindergarten to grade 4 students will continue to be accommodated at Tuscany School for the 2009-2010 school year. We will continue to monitor enrolment annually and engage parents and other stakeholders if any changes to the student accommodation plan for students residing in Tuscany are necessary.

For the 2009-2010 school year, the designated schools for regular program students residing in Tuscany are as follows:

Kindergarten to grade 4 students at Marion Carson School

During the transition year of opening the new Tuscany School some students in grades 1-3 were accepted at Marion Carson School for September 2006 as parents wanted to keep siblings together. These students are now in grade 4 and are considered eligible for subsidized transportation. We will continue to consider these students eligible for subsidized transportation for the 2009-2010 school year.

All new registrations from the Tuscany community in kindergarten to grade 4 are designated to Tuscany School. Families wishing to register siblings at Marion Carson School for kindergarten to grade 4 may individually register with the principal at Marion Carson School. New students would be considered out of attendance area students and would be accepted only as space and resources allow. If accepted, these students would need to apply for transportation as conditional riders.

All students accessing subsidized transportation are required to pay Board approved transportation fees. Information regarding transportation services and fees is available on the CBE website www.cbe.ab.ca and at the schools.
