Battalion Park School is located in the residential district of Signal Hill. Effective 2008-2009, Battalion Park School was designated as a bus receiver school for students residing in Springbank Hill. Battalion Park School is currently at capacity and cannot accommodate all students residing in Springbank Hill. Students who cannot be accommodated at Battalion Park School are designated to Glenbrook School. The following Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ's) provide further detail regarding admission to Glenbrook School.

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ's)

Regular Program Kindergarten to Grade 6 School Designation for Students Residing in the Springbank Hill Residential District

1. Why are students residing in Springbank Hill designated to Battalion Park School when the school is at or near capacity?

Students are accommodated as close to home as possible. Effective 2008-2009 school year, students from Springbank Hill are designated to Battalion Park School. There is limited space available at Battalion Park School therefore not all students residing in Springbank Hill can be accommodated at Battalion Park School. Students who cannot be accommodated at Battalion Park School are designated to Glenbrook School.

2. How do I find out if there is space for my child/children at Battalion Park School?

Parents residing in Springbank Hill should contact Battalion Park School to determine whether there is space available to accommodate their child/children and to be placed on the priority list if necessary. If your child/children cannot be accommodated at Battalion Park School, you will be asked to register your child/children at Glenbrook School.

A list of students based on the priorities listed below will be maintained at Battalion Park School and will be used to determine a student's priority for transferring to Battalion Park School when space becomes available.

3. What are the priorities for admission into Battalion Park School for kindergarten?

- All kindergarten students residing in the attendance area for Battalion Park School (Signal Hill).
- Kindergarten students residing in Springbank Hill who have a sibling attending Battalion Park School.
- Kindergarten registrations from the residential district of Springbank Hill will be accepted based on registration date and time until the maximum of 100 kindergarten students is reached.

4. What are the priorities for admission if space is available at Battalion Park School?

- Students registered at Glenbrook School.
- Students registered at other Calgary Board of Education schools/programs such as Traditional Learning Centre, French Immersion, Spanish Bilingual.
- Students registered at charter or private schools.
- Non-resident students, for example, Calgary Catholic, Rockyview, Foothills School Divisions.
