Issue:

- Royal Oak School will be over capacity in 2012
- Simon Fraser School will be at or near capacity in 2012
- An overflow bus receiver school needs to be identified

Purpose of the meeting:

- To discuss options for accommodating Rocky Ridge and Royal Oak students
- To gather feedback on opportunities and challenges of scenarios
- To explain the decision making process

Background

- ❑ June 2007 New P3 elementary school approved
- ❑ November 2007 Reviewed options for RRRO with parent representatives
- ❑ February 2008 Open House
- ❑ March 2008 Reviewed open house feedback and new possibilities
- ❑ April 2008 Designation letter went home
- ❑ September 2010 Royal Oak School Opens

Middle School Status

- ❑ 2012-2015 School Capital Plan ranked RRRO Middle School as the #2 priority
- ❑ A funding announcement was made by the provincial government in May 2011
- ❑ 2013-2016 School Capital Plan will be released in early 2012

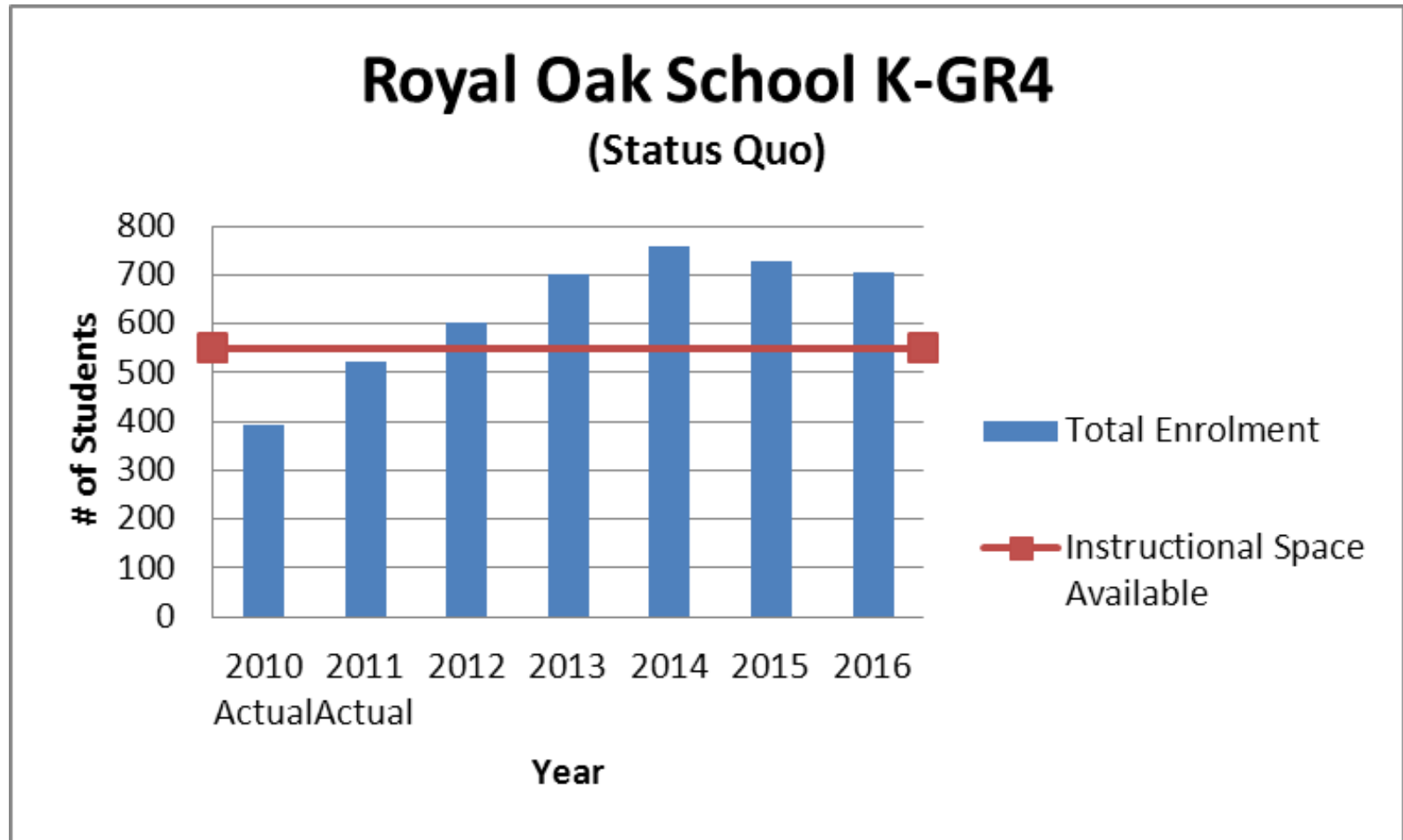


Royal Oak School Enrolment – September 30, 2011

Instructional Space Available = 550

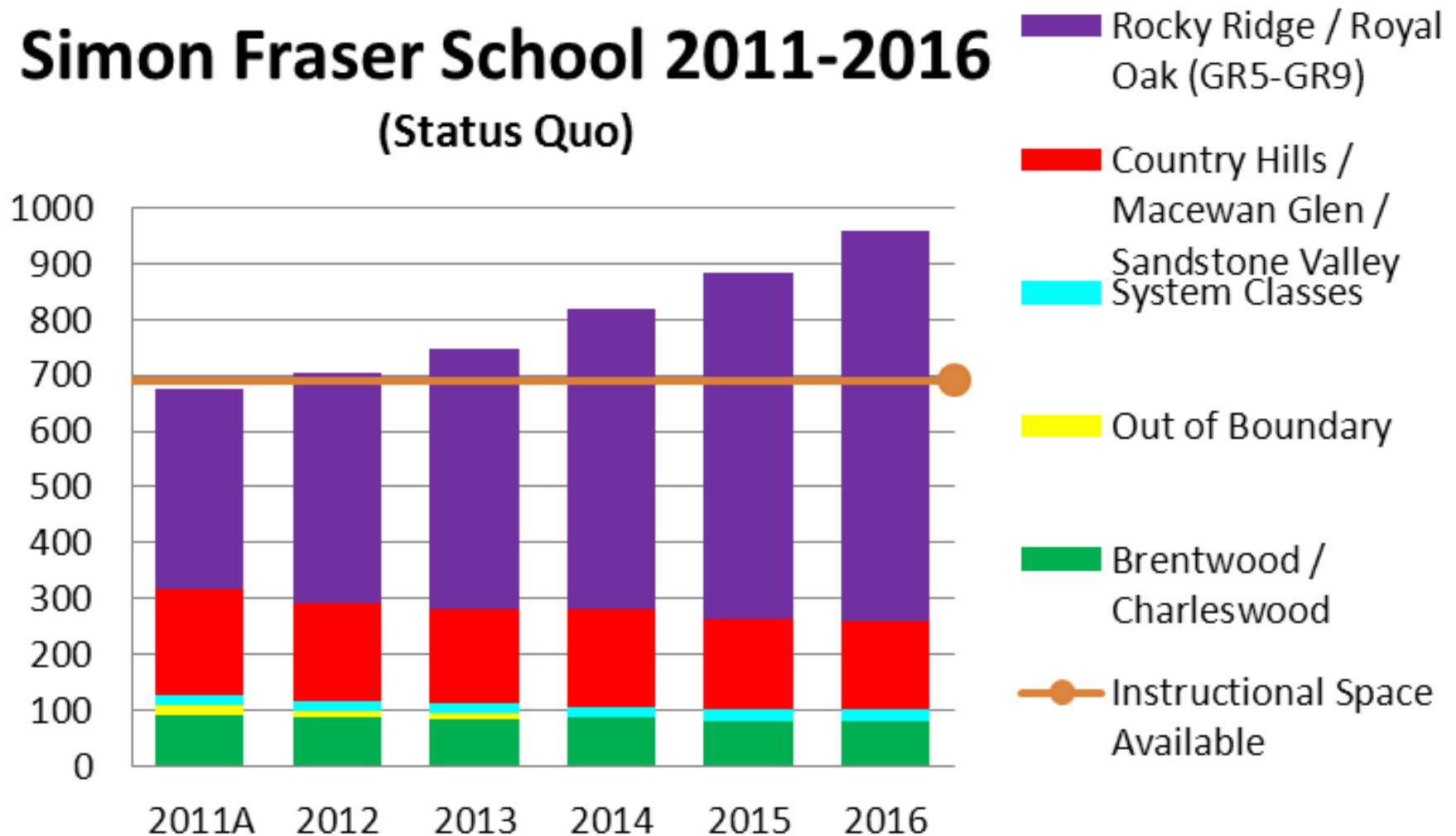

Options for Rocky Ridge/Royal Oak Students

- ❑ Option #1 – change grade configuration at Royal Oak School (K-3)
 - ❑ Identify a school with space to accommodate GR4-GR6 students
- ❑ Option #2 – keep current grade configuration (K-4) and cap enrolment at Royal Oak School
 - ❑ Identify an overflow bus receiver

Option #1 Change Grade Configuration at Royal Oak School

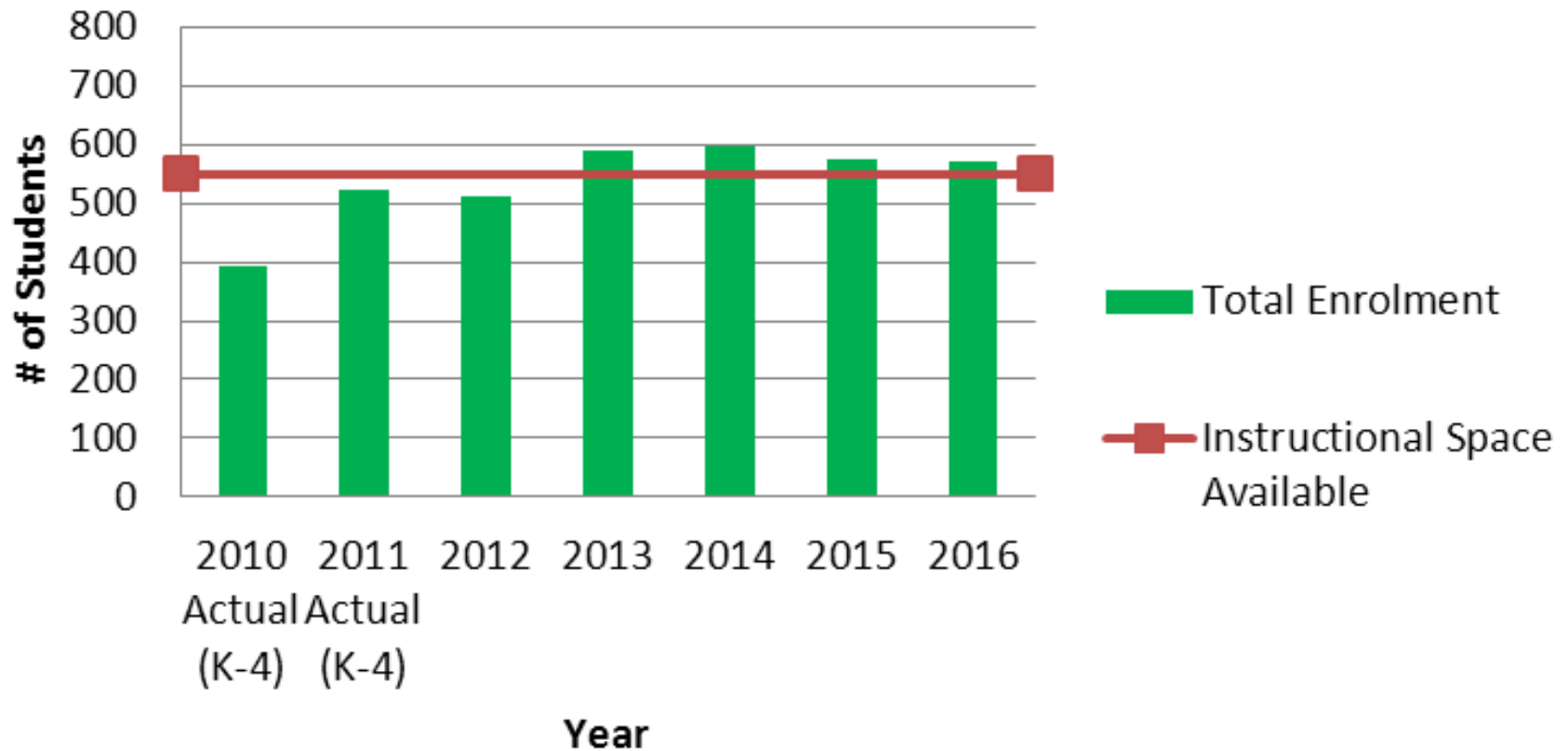
- Royal Oak K-3
- Belvedere-Parkway grades 4-6
- Simon Fraser grades 7-9

Impacts of Option #1

- ❑ All K-GR3 students can be accommodated at Royal Oak School for the next 5 years
- ❑ Current grade 3 students would be designated to Belvedere-Parkway for grade 4
- ❑ Current grade 5 and 6 students would remain at Simon Fraser School through to the end of grade 9
- ❑ Current grade 4 students would be designated to Belvedere Parkway for grade 5 and 6 in 2012 and Simon Fraser for grade 7 in 2014
- ❑ Simon Fraser School would accommodate grades 7-9 only

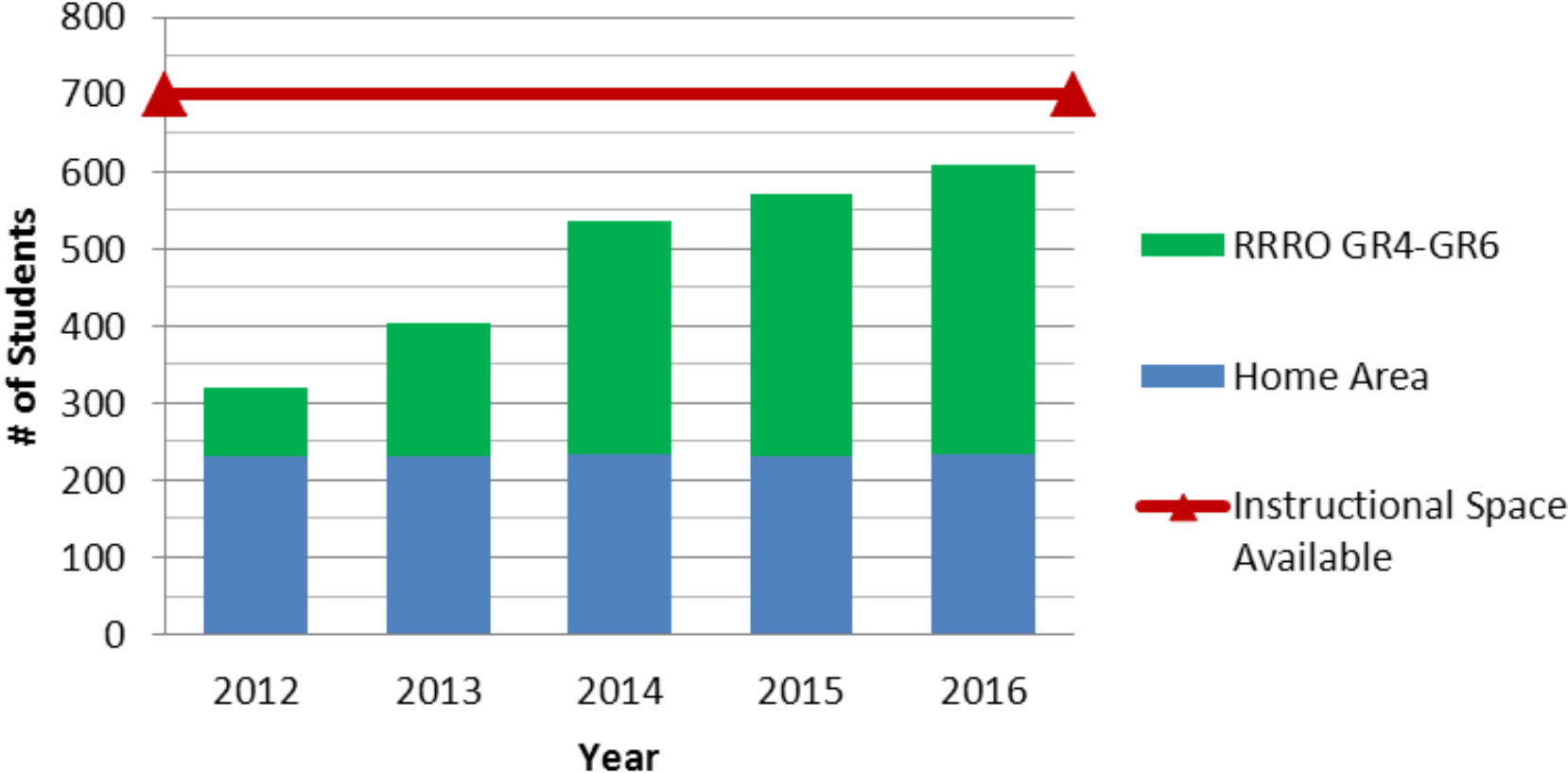
Royal Oak School Projected Enrolment – Option #1

Royal Oak School K-GR3



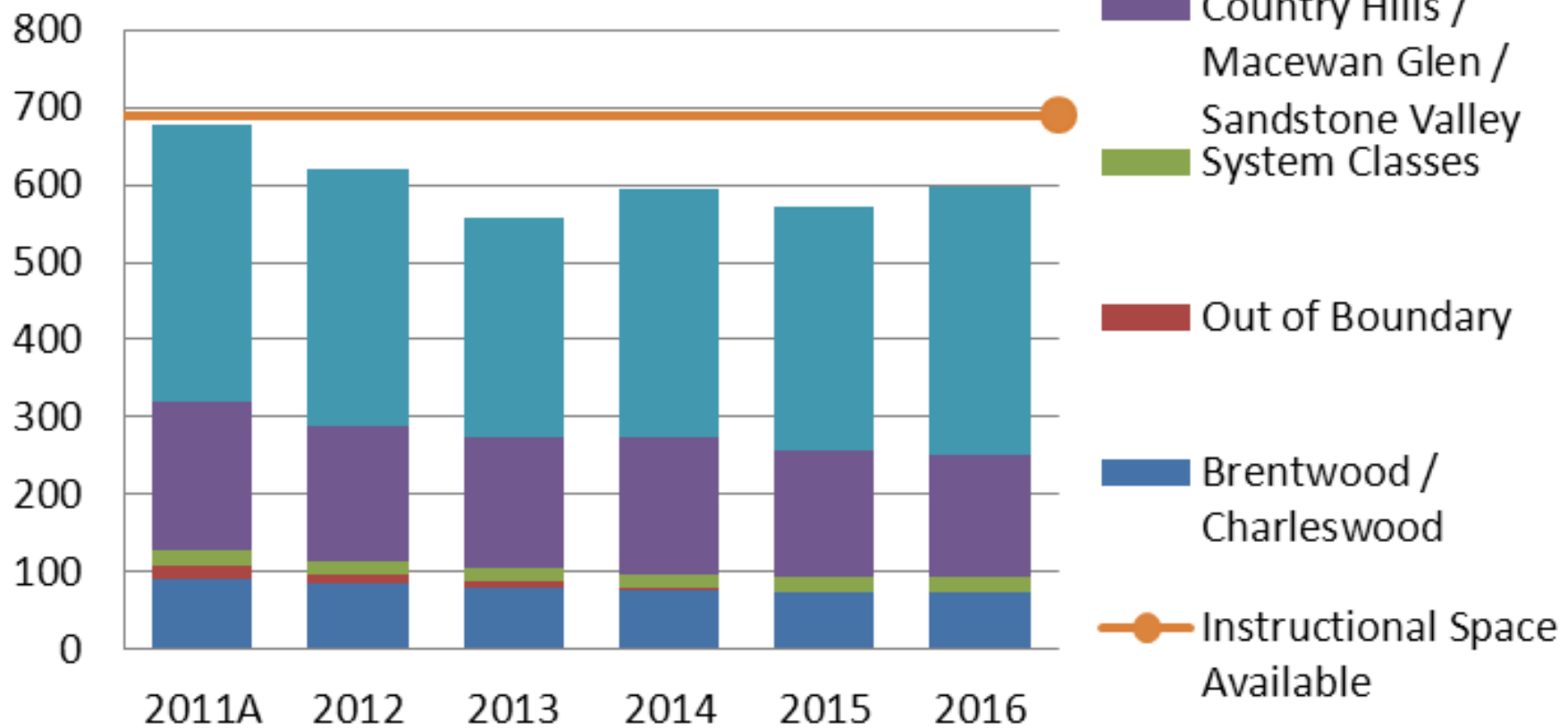
Belvedere Parkway School Projected Enrolment – Option #1

Option #2 Cap Enrolment at Royal Oak School

- ❑ Royal Oak School K-4
 - ❑ Cap enrolment at Royal Oak at either 100 or 110 students/grade
 - ❑ Overflow K-4 students who cannot be accommodated at Royal Oak School to another school

Option #2

- ❑ Royal Oak K-4 ~~Simon Fraser~~ → Simon Fraser 5-9
 - ❑ Only students attending Royal Oak School would continue to attend Simon Fraser for GR5-GR9

- ❑ Overflow Options
 - ❑ Belvedere Parkway K-6 → T.B. Riley 7-9

 - ❑ Marion Carson K-6 → F.E. Osborne 7-9
 - ❑ Only students attending the overflow K-GR6 school would continue on to junior high school with peers from the overflow bus receiver

Impacts of Option #2

- Kindergarten enrolment would be capped
- Some students currently in K and GR1 may not be able to remain at Royal Oak School
- Current grade 5 and 6 students would remain at Simon Fraser School
- Students attending Royal Oak School would be designated to Simon Fraser School for GR5-GR9
- Students attending the K-GR6 overflow school would not attend Simon Fraser School
- New k-6 students would be designated to the overflow bus receiver and would continue with that peer group for GR7-GR9
- Attendance criteria and recall process required

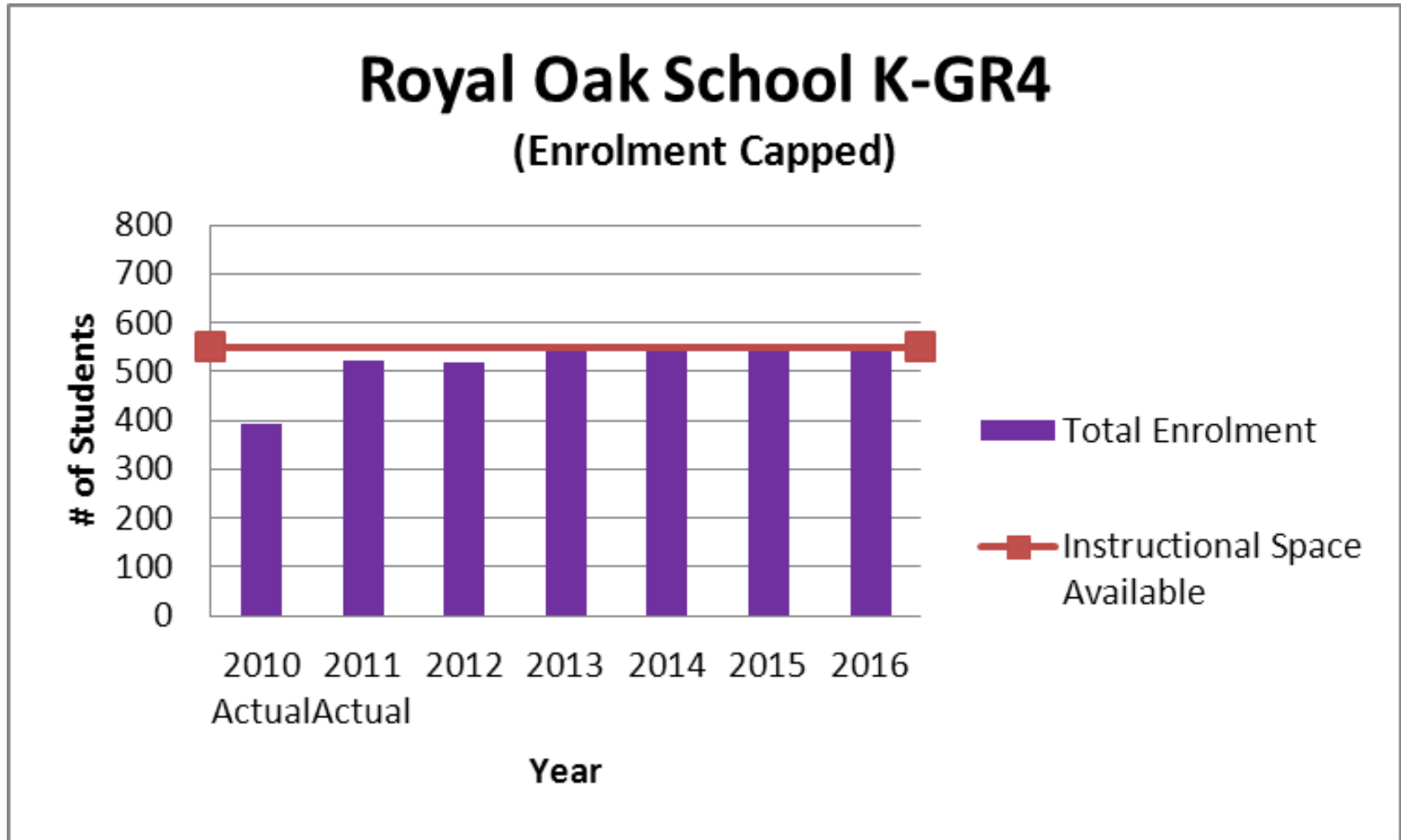

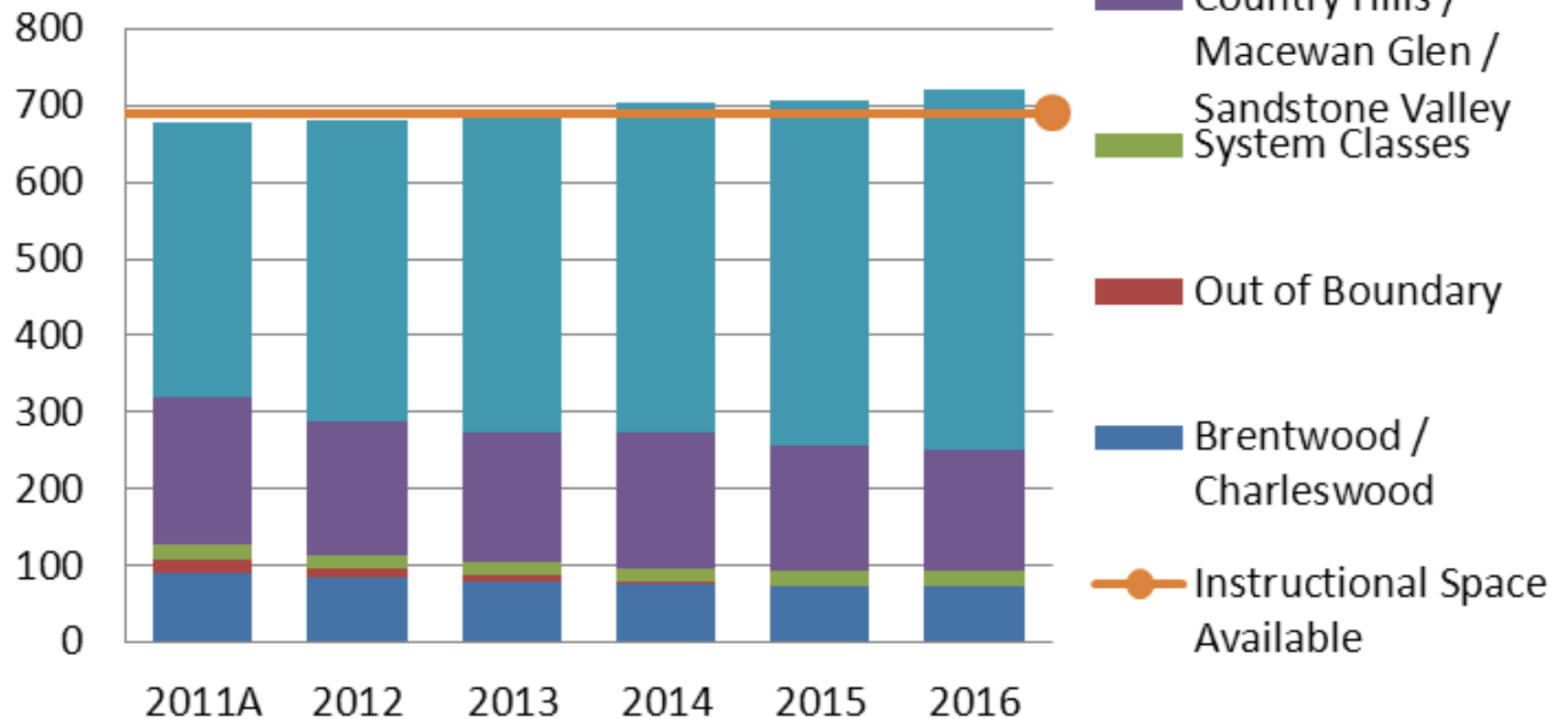

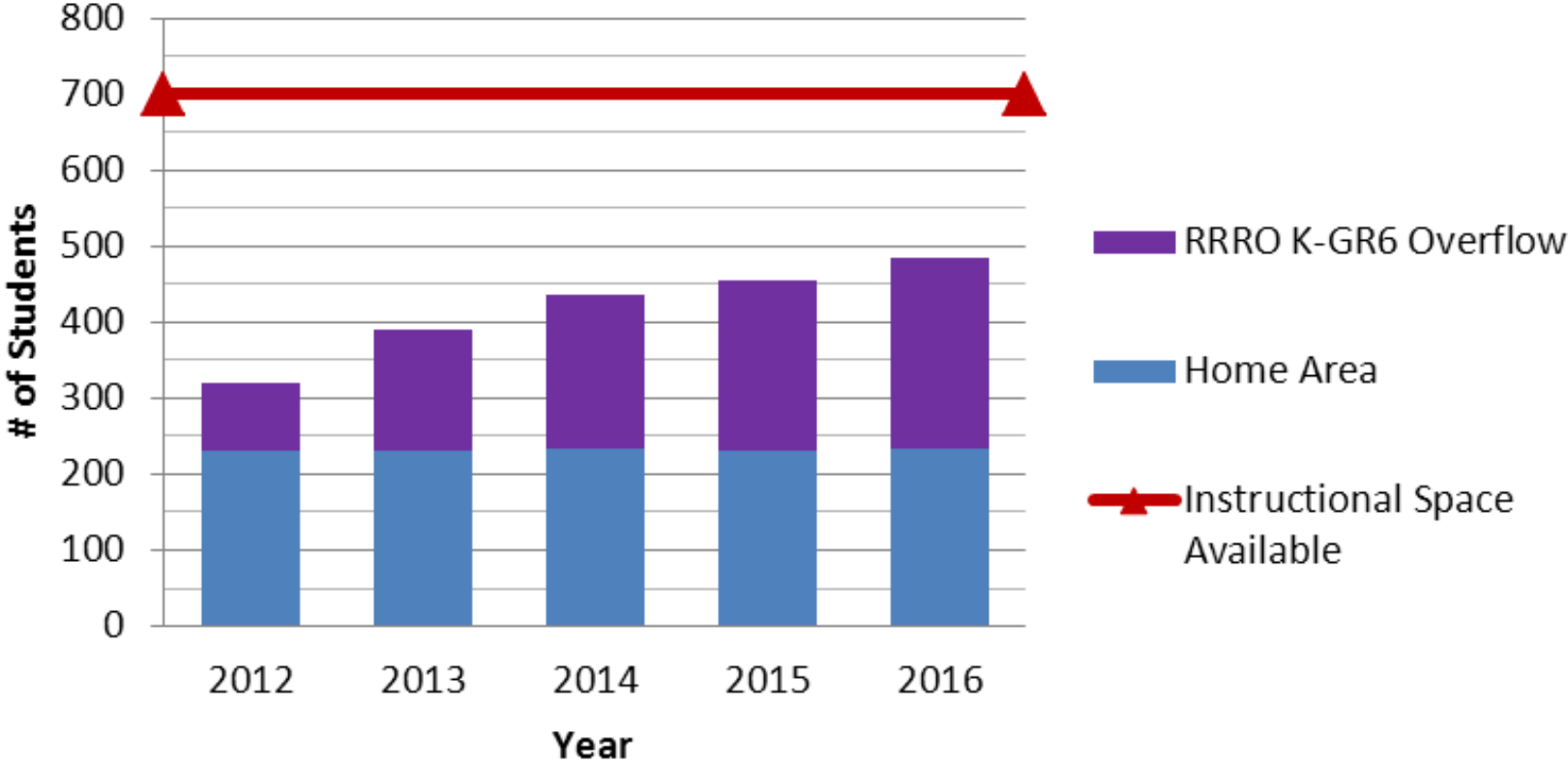

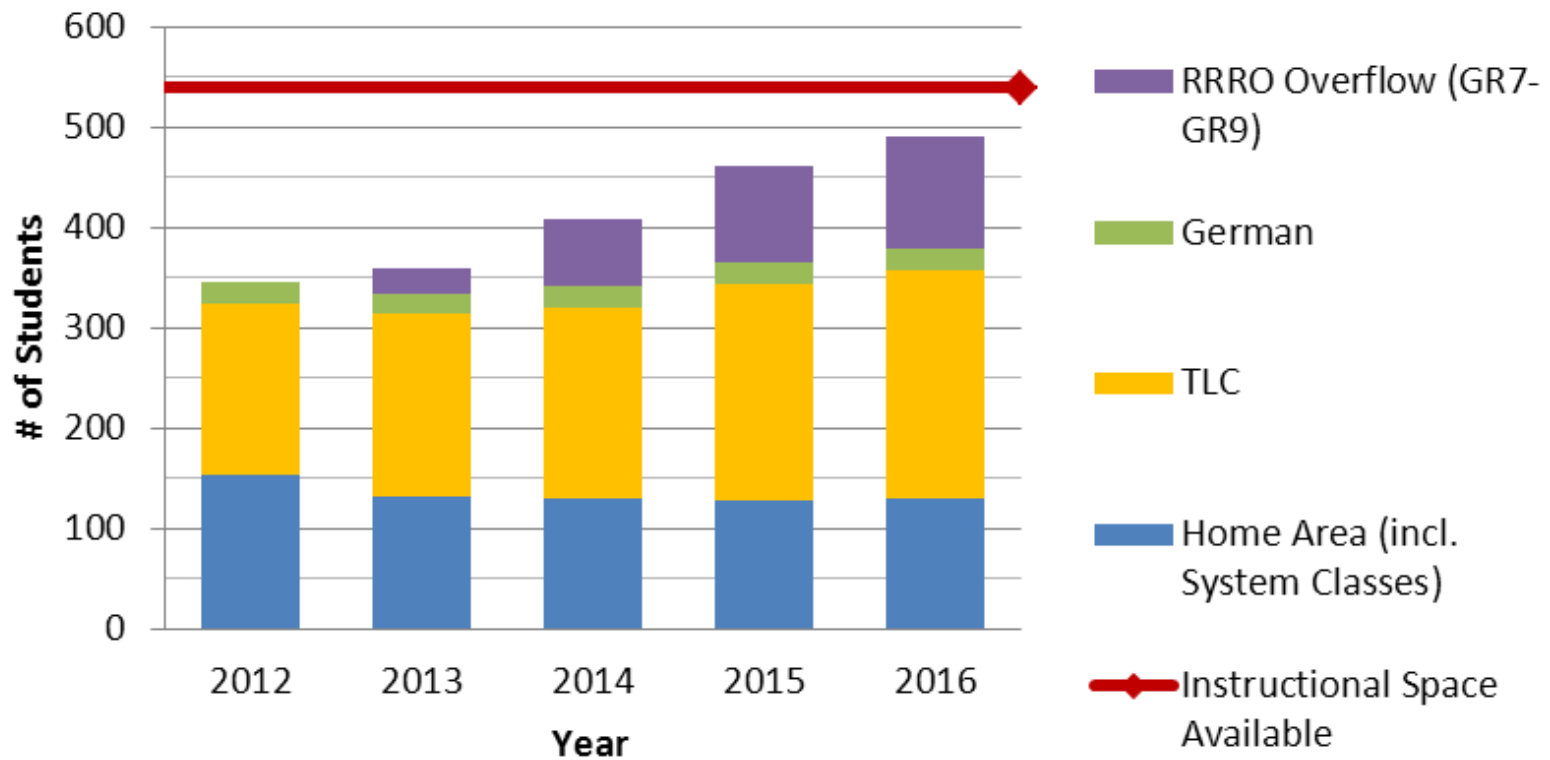
Belvedere Parkway School Projected Enrolment – Option#2

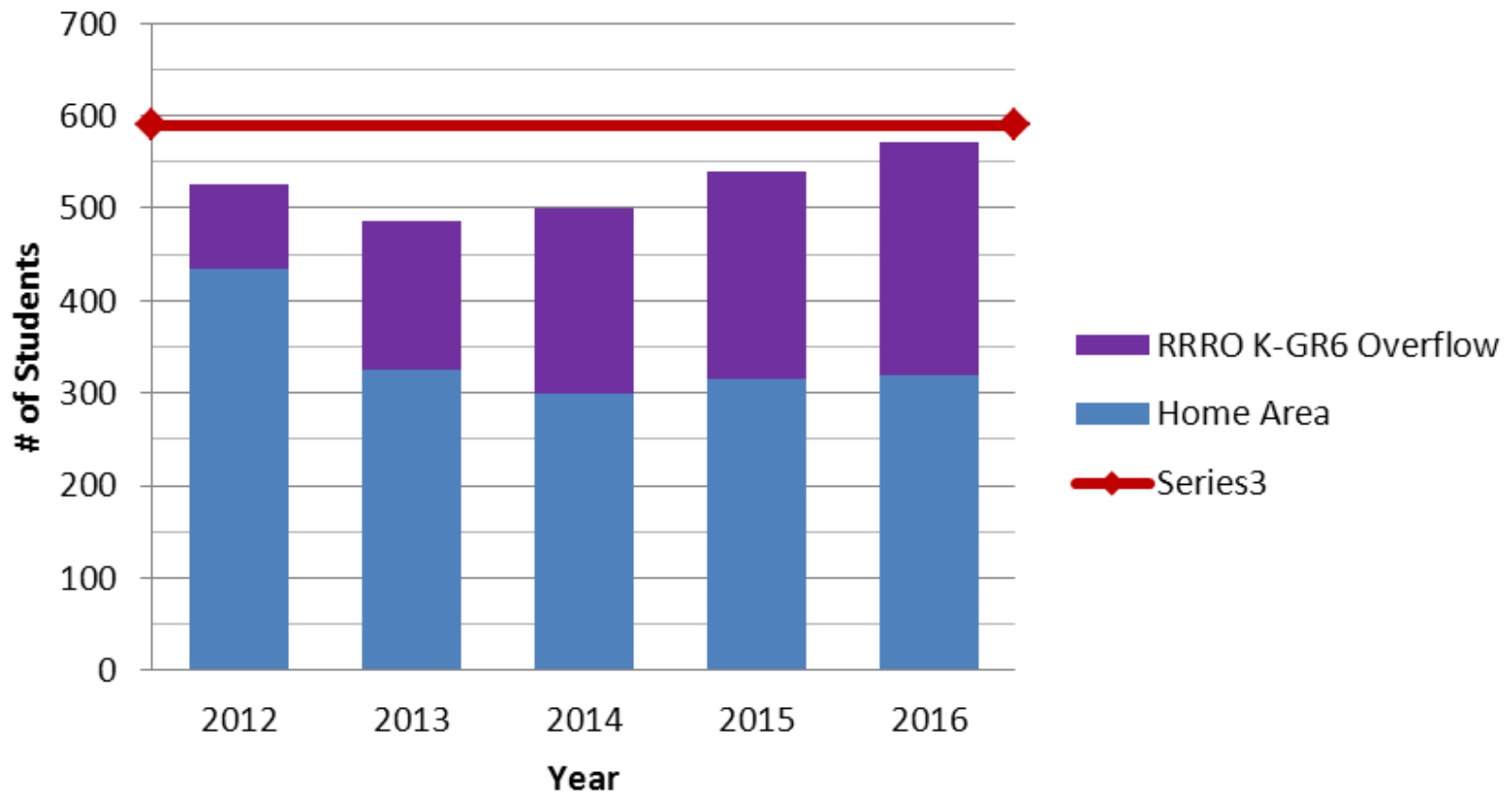

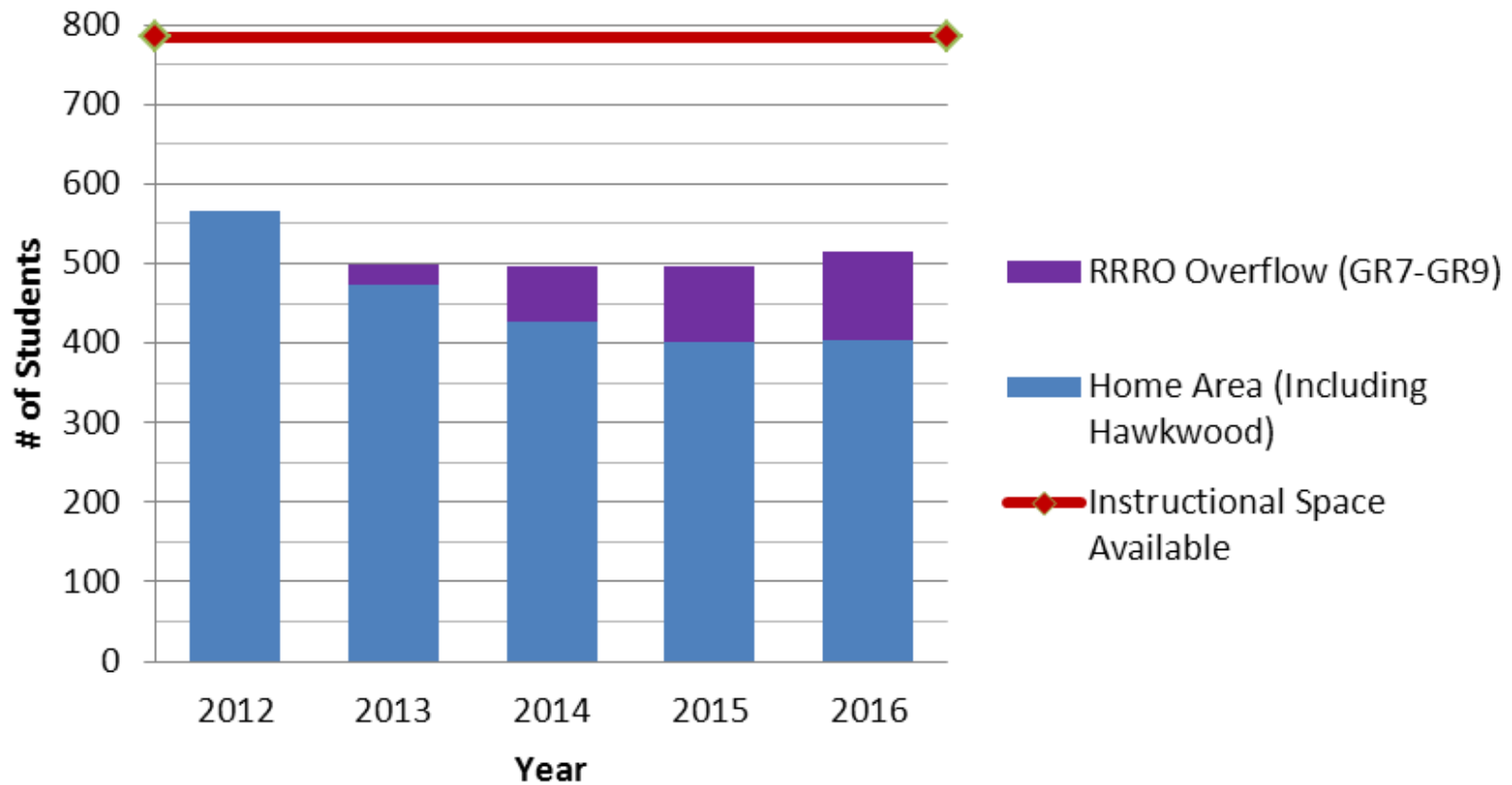
Marion Carson School Projected Enrolment – Option#2
