



















## SOUTHERN ALBERTA JUBILEE AUDITORIUM



Since 1957, the Southern Alberta Jubilee Auditorium has been the center of arts and culture in Southern Alberta. A gift to commemorate the province's 50th anniversary, the Jubilee Auditorium (known locally as 'The Jube') has been the host venue for entertainment from across Canada and around the world.

In 2016, The Jube opened its doors to a new era of collaboration with Calgarians, evolving from a presenting venue to become a destination for inspired learning and hands-on creativity. Propelled by a new partnership with innovative school program Campus Calgary / Open Minds, the Jubilee Auditorium became the home of 'Jube School' – inviting youth, educators and parent volunteers to explore all this dynamic facility has to offer. The inaugural pilot program featured 6-weeks of programming.

In 2017, Jube School became an official member of the Campus Calgary / Open Minds family, offering a completely new experience for Calgary students. Tailored to each attending classes' curriculum, their Jube School experience draws on the Jubilee Auditorium's technical theatre experts in lighting, sound, movement, stage carpentry and makeup to create unforgettable learning opportunities.

Additionally, Jube School draws on its relationships with artists of every discipline in Southern Alberta, inviting a diverse and inspired mosaic of creativity to enhance and excite students through arts-based learning. Working alongside the technical experts and guest artists, students experience new levels of expression, collaboration and inspiration – learning in ways their minds never imagined.
