
Background

- Online surveys were available to CBE students, staff, parents and community members May 29 – June 11, 2020. This report is for the parent results.
- The total number of valid responses on the staff survey was 41,889.
 More than 230 responses were deemed to be invalid (attempts to skew results) and removed from the survey data.
- The purpose of the survey was to gather feedback from stakeholders on possible scenarios for when classes start again in fall 2020.
- This report includes quantitative survey results only. Comments provided on the survey were forwarded to the relevant service units for review and consideration.


Number of CBE Students Per Family

How many children do you have enrolled in CBE schools for September 2020? (Responses: 38,022)




Student Grade Level

What grade(s) are your children enrolled in for September 2020?




Special Needs

Yellow Bus Transportation


Do your children require yellow bus transportation to get to school? (Responses: 37,927)




Yellow Bus Transportation

Would you feel comfortable transporting your children on the yellow school bus in the fall? (Responses: 11,654)


Do you have the capacity to drive your children or have them driven to school this fall if necessary? (Responses: 11,346)






Calgary Transit

Do your children take Calgary Transit to get to school? (Responses: 37,812)





Do you feel comfortable with your children taking Calgary Transit to and from school in the fall? (Responses: 11,999)




Student Health

Family Health


Does anyone in your household have underlying health issues that may put them at higher risk should they be exposed to COVID-19? (Responses: 38,985)


In-Person Learning






Blended Learning




Please indicate how much you agree or disagree with the following statements about the time since online learning began in March 2020. (Responses: 36,259 to 36,377)






How comfortable are you with having your children continue with online learning in the fall? (Responses: 36,444)




How confident are you that you will be able to support your children's online learning in the fall given considerations such as work, childcare, other obligations, etc.?

Please indicate how much you agree or disagree with the following statements about the time since online learning began in March 2020. (Responses: 36,450 to 36,557)






Top Concerns
