# Reminder about school council annual reports

Under The School Act, school councils are responsible to submit an annual report to the Board of Trustees. This report helps the Board of Trustees measure and be accountable for parent and community involvement. The school council chair is responsible for submitting the report to the Board of Trustees by June 15. Although the School Act states a Sept. 30 deadline, trustees would appreciate receiving the report prior to the end of June 2015 if possible. A copy of the report should also be provided to the school principal.
