Administrative Regulation 1002 - School Philosophy and Goals

The purpose of the Calgary Board of Education is to ensure individual student development through effective education.

Within this purpose, the Board expects each school to develop a statement of educational philosophy and to outline goals to meet the needs of the students and expectations of the school community.

1. The development of a school philosophy is the responsibility of the principal in consultation with staff, taking into account student needs, parent expectations, and resources.
2. Priorities should be developed which emanate from the school philosophy and which are consistent with the "Goals of Schooling" and "Goals of Education" as approved by the Province of Alberta.
3. It is expected that each school communicate its philosophy and priorities to students and parents.
4. The school philosophy and priorities shall form the basis of communication between the school and the Area Office when discussing school needs.
