Administrative Regulation 3041 - Closing Exercises

To emphasize the importance of graduation from high school and to recognize the achievement of those about to attain this goal, the Board directs that closing exercises be held in each of the senior high schools in the late spring each year requesting that a Trustee be named to attend. The principal or designate of each senior high school must send an invitation to the Board of trustees.

Graduation programs shall contain a message to the students from the Chair of the Board.

If closing exercises are held in elementary and junior high schools, they shall be as simple as possible. Any endeavours to elaborate student dress by either sex on such occasion shall not be encouraged by the staff of the school.
