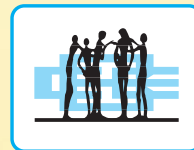

The Traditional Learning Centre

The Calgary Board of Education is proud to offer an alternative program of traditional learning and university preparatory schooling. The Traditional Learning Centre's virtues-oriented school environment prepares students to meet the moral, technological and global challenges of the 21st century.

This classical education program features:

- Direct whole-group instruction for language arts and mathematics
- Early literacy developed through explicit phonics, spelling and grammar
- Sequential learning that is structured, enriched and purposeful
- Mastery of basics for reading and mathematics skill development
- A virtues-focused environment to develop responsible citizenship
- Character education to develop critical, reflective thinking

The CBE **Traditional Learning Centre** uses direct instruction and character education to foster reflective thinking, continuous learning and responsible citizenship.



The Traditional Learning Centre has been in operation since September 2002. As of September 2009, the program had over 3900 students at thirteen sites throughout the city.

Additional program features include:

- Emphasis on developing concentration and organizational skills
- French as a Second Language at Grade 1
- Band at Grade 5 in middle schools
- Technology to enhance instruction
- Leadership opportunities
- Regular homework
- School uniforms
- Committed parent support
- Vertical enrichment beginning in middle school
- Enriched programs such as Advanced Placement or International Baccalaureate in high school.

Although the Traditional Learning Centre is academically rigorous, it is not reserved for elite students. The program is designed for all students who are motivated to work with teachers and parents to thoroughly develop their ability to achieve excellence in a structured, virtues-oriented environment.
