## what

- The DELF (Diplôme d'études en langue française) is an official diploma awarded by the National Ministry of Education of France and recognized around the world.
- It is based on the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR)
- The French exams are currently used in over 160 countries in the world
- The DELF exam assesses all four language competencies - oral production, written production, listening comprehension and written comprehension.
- Students receive a lifelong diploma upon successful completion at each level.
