Late French Immersion

The Calgary Board of Education believes that every child can learn an additional language. With the support of highly qualified and dedicated teachers, your child will experience an engaging and supportive learning environment to learn in the target language. Late French Immersion is designed for students whose first language is not French. No previous knowledge or experience with the French language is required to enroll. All core subjects (French Language Arts, Math, Social Studies and Science) will be taught in French in grades 7,8,9. High school offers French Language Arts, Math and Social Studies.

What are the benefits of learning an additional language?

- Learning French as an additional language offers students significant linguistic, academic, and cognitive benefits. It opens doors to knowledge, communication, culture and travel, and gives students an edge in the global job market.
- Increases a student's feelings of self-esteem and pride in knowing another language.
- Enhances problem-solving abilities.
- Children who learn a second language show either comparable or enhanced first-language literacy.
