
### **Our Mission and Values**

#### **CBE Current Situation**

- Just over 3,700 new students enrolled at the CBE as of September 30<sup>th</sup>
  - Most significant increase is at the elementary level:

Grades 1-3 (1,677 students)

Grades 4-6 (1,051 students)

Our total enrolment is now 114,472 students

# **CBE Capital Projects**

- Already announced 17 major capital projects are well underway:
  - 12 new schools
  - 3 major modernizations
  - 2 replacement schools
- We are targeting completion of these projects for 2016

#### Starter Schools Announcement

- September 22, 2014, Province announced \$26.8 million for four starter schools:
  - West Springs / Cougar Ridge (middle school)
  - Cranston (middle school)
  - Saddle Ridge (elementary school)
  - Aspen Woods (elementary school)
- On October 8, the Province committed to the immediate planning of the final designs of these schools.

### Starter Schools Announcement

- In addition, the Province announced:
  - 7 modular classrooms and a washroom for Westgate School (\$2.8 million)
  - Preliminary Design of a new South East High School (\$1.0 million)


# More Capital Projects Announced

- October 8, 2014, Province announced Phase III of a consolidated advancement of education capital projects, including the design of three CBE schools:
  - Martindale(elementary school)
  - Silverado (elementary school)
  - Springbank Hill / Discovery Ridge (elementary/middle school)
- Modernization designs for James Fowler and Lord Beaverbrook high schools

# **Progress Update**

CBE now has 31 capital projects underway

 Scheduled openings between September 2016 and September 2018



## **Progress Update**

Establishing Steering Committees for 10 new projects

 Development Permits for 18 projects were submitted to the City of Calgary over the summer

## **Progress Update**

- Fixed price, lump sum RFPs have been posted for six schools. Expect appointments by the end of February 2014.
- Construction managers appointed for modernization projects
  - Carbon Constructors Inc. Jack James HS
  - Chandos Construction Bowness HS

#### Modular Classrooms

- 4 modular classrooms installed by the CBE at Dalhousie School
- The Province will be installing 2 modular classrooms each at Saddle Ridge School and West Springs School – scheduled to be completed in November 2014
- The Board of Trustees approved the 2015/16 Modular Classroom Plan on October 14 and submitted the request to the Province
  - 28 modulars at 11 CBE schools
