#### Increasing Level of Public Impact

## Public participation

goal

To provide the public with balanced and objective information to assist them in understanding the problem, alternatives, opportunities and/or solutions.

Inform

#### Consult

To obtain public feedback on analysis, alternatives and/or decisions.

#### Involve

To work directly with the public throughout the process to ensure that public concerns and aspirations are consistently understood and considered.

#### Collaborate

To partner with the public in each aspect of the decision including the development of alternatives and the identification of the preferred solution.

## **Empower**To place final

To place final decision-making in the hands of the public.

#### Promise to the public

We will keep you informed.

We will keep you informed, listen to and acknowledge concerns and aspirations, and provide feedback on how public input influenced the decision.

We will work with you to ensure that your concerns and aspirations are directly reflected in the alternatives developed and provide feedback on how public input influenced the decision. We will look to you for advice and innovation in formulating solutions and incorporate your advice and recommendations into the decisions to the maximum extent possible. We will implement what you decide.



### Consult

Our goal is to *consult* with you by obtaining your feedback on:

 Scenarios that address the accommodation continuum for K-9 students living in Evanston

### By *consult*, we mean that

 We will keep you and other identified stakeholders informed, listen to and acknowledge your concerns and aspirations, and provide feedback on how your input was used to influence the final decision



### Issue

The opening of the new school in Evanston provides an opportunity to review the school accommodation plan for kindergarten through grade 9 students living in the community.

- the selection of an accommodation scenario
- the implementation of the accommodation scenario

The final decision on programs and grade configuration will be made by the Area Director and the Director of Planning & Transportation.

### Current situation

Currently K-9 students are bused to 3 different schools, 2 elementary schools (K-GR6) and 1 junior high (GR7-9).



## Long term capital plan

Long term plan for the K-GR9 learning continuum is a K-4 at the new Evanston elementary with yet to be approved middle school which would accommodate students in GR5-9.

Currently, the middle school for the community has been requested through our 3 Year School Capital Plan 2016-2019 and it is ranked as 22<sup>nd</sup> on the priority list.

Community rankings are revised annually to reflect demographic trends and changes in student populations.



## New Evanston elementary

The new Evanston elementary will accommodate students K-GR4. We have two concepts:

- continue with GR5-6 going to an elementary school when they leave the new school and moving again to a Junior High School or
- Designate students to a middle school (GR5-9) after they leave the new school





- Georges P. Vanier School GR7-9


Note: Current GR3-5 students at North Haven could finish their division at the school or transfer to Cambrian Heights




