Reminder Notice: Traditional Learning Centre designations in Area II

The Calgary Board of Education (CBE) would like to *remind* parents that the Traditional Learning Centre (TLC) alternative program at Colonel Irvine School will expand for the 2015-2016 school year. This decision was originally communicated in a letter dated March 4, 2011.

2015-2016 School Year and Subsequent school years

- Kindergarten to Grade 4 – Dr. J.K. Mulloy School
- Grades 5 to 9 – Colonel Irvine School

Colonel Irvine School is located in the residential district of Highwood at 412 Northmount Drive N.W.; phone 403-777-7280.

Students from the residential districts of Highwood, North Haven and Cambrian Heights will have the option to attend either Balmoral School or Colonel Irvine School for the TLC program in Grades 5 to 9.

Transportation Services

Students attending Colonel Irvine School from the residential districts of Highwood, North Haven, and Cambrian Heights are considered to be within the walk distance to the school. Transportation will continue to be provided to Balmoral School and students can access the nearest congregated stop.
