



Families using the City of Calgary Fair Entry Program to purchase low-income monthly transit passes are eligible to receive a rebate of up to \$549 for the purchases Calgary Transit monthly youth passes, the amount equal to the funding received by the CBE from the Provincial Government for their transportation.

Proof of Acceptance into the Fair Entry Program

To claim a rebate for a low-income monthly transit pass purchases, families will need to upload a copy of a valid approval letter when they register. You must also select the income Band indicated on the letter.

If the letter expires during the school year, you are responsible for updating this information on your account to ensure you continue to receive the appropriate rebate.

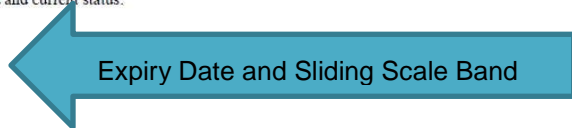
