

Before beginning this process, you should scan or take a picture of the letter provided to you by the CBE, which includes the Volunteer Organization Authorization Number (VOAN). You should also scan or take pictures of 2 pieces of valid government issued ID, with at least one being a piece of photo ID. Pictures or scans of both sides of the identification are required.

Acceptable valid government issued non-photo ID includes:

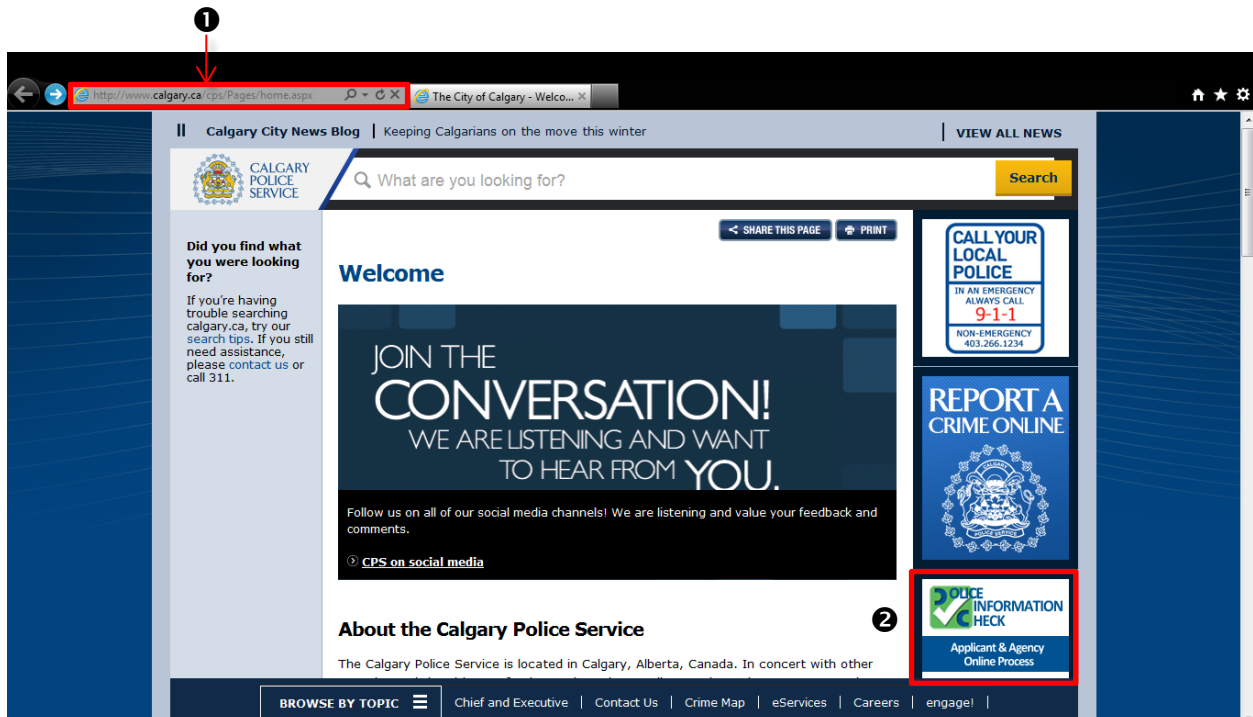
- Provincial Healthcare Card
- Birth Certificate
- Marriage Certificate
- Immigration Papers
- Citizenship Card (Issued within the last 5 years)
- Citizenship Certificate

Acceptable valid government issued photo ID includes:

- Driver's License
- Alberta Photo Identification Card (Issued through Registry Agent Offices)
- Passport
- Permanent Residency Card
- Firearms License
- Nexus Card
- Secure Certificate of Indian Status Card (Federally issued)
- Aviation Document Booklet

You will need to upload copies of these files to the Police Information Check (PIC) system for identification verification purposes.
