



Student Expectations:

- I will stay with my group during all activities and not go anywhere alone
- I will not give out any personal information (last name, social media information, phone number) to a guest or resident of The Mustard Seed
- I will limit physical contact with guests and residents of The Mustard Seed to handshakes, high fives, and fist bumps
- I will inform a leader if I feel uncomfortable or unsafe at any time
- I will respect the property of The Mustard Seed and help keep the SEEDschool classroom tidy
- I will use my journal and share my learning with others
- I will engage in learning, ask questions, and listen well

Parent Volunteer Expectations:

- I will let the students take the lead in their learning by letting them wonder, make mistakes, and make decisions
- I will sit with/near my group during activities, encouraging them to engage and participate
- When we leave The Mustard Seed's property, I will space myself out amongst students as we walk to our next location and will watch out for the students around me, ensuring that they stay to the right, leave space for others, and cross the street safely by only crossing when there is a walk signal and stopping to wait for the next light when the signal shows numbers or a hand.
- On the C-train, I will keep my group together, encourage students to use good manners and enter and leave the vehicle calmly
- I will respect and follow The Mustard Seed's student bathroom policies:
 - Students are always accompanied to the washroom area.
 No exceptions.
 - Before any student enters the general washroom area, adult volunteers ensure that the area is safe and appropriate (not necessarily empty).
 - Adult volunteers remain in hallway outside washroom until all students are out.
- I set a good example for learning by not using my cell phone while in the classroom
- I will help keep the SEEDschool classroom tidy
- As a role model for students, I will journal alongside them whenever possible and keep notes on my own learning
- I will inform a staff of The Mustard Seed in the case of an emergency or student crisis
