



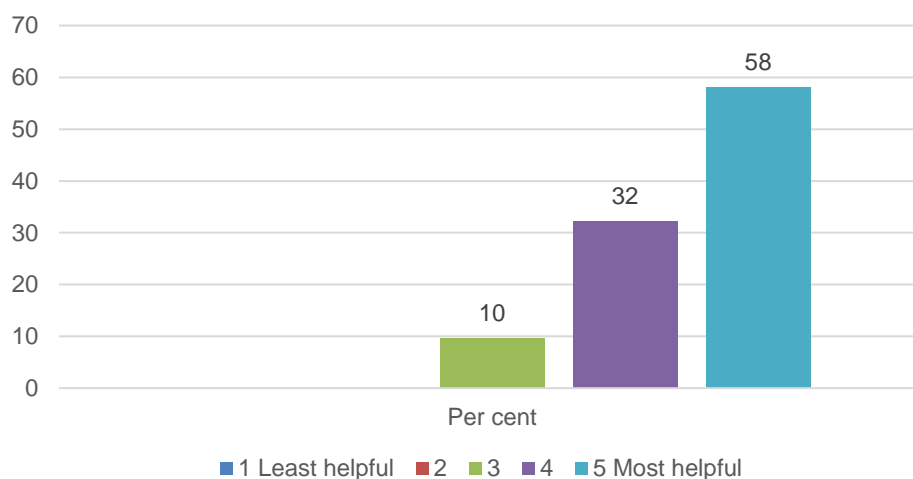
Understanding Child(ren)'s Progress and Achievement

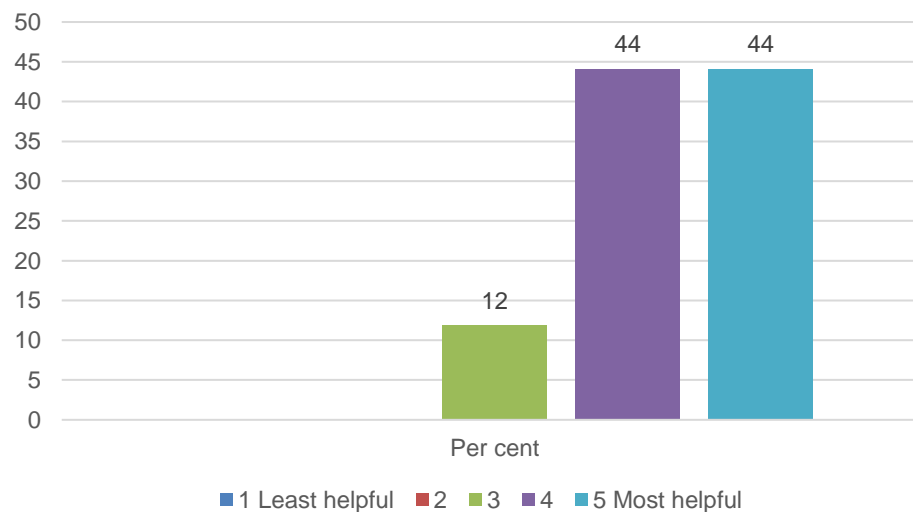
90 per cent of respondents gave "parent/teacher interviews nights" a 4 or a 5.

Parent/Teacher interview



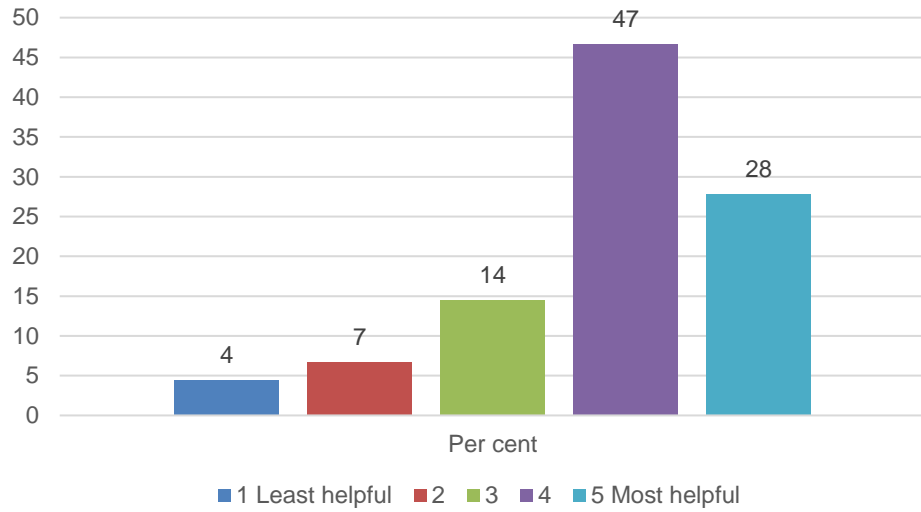
88 per cent of respondents gave "phone calls / emails with teachers" a 4 or a 5.

Phone calls/emails with teachers



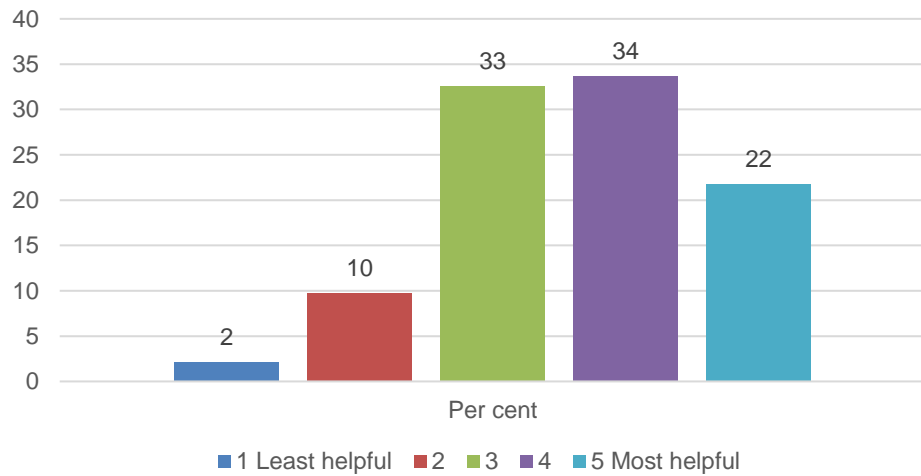
75 per cent of respondents gave “texts, quizzes, assignments” a 4 or a 5.

Tests, quizzes, assignments



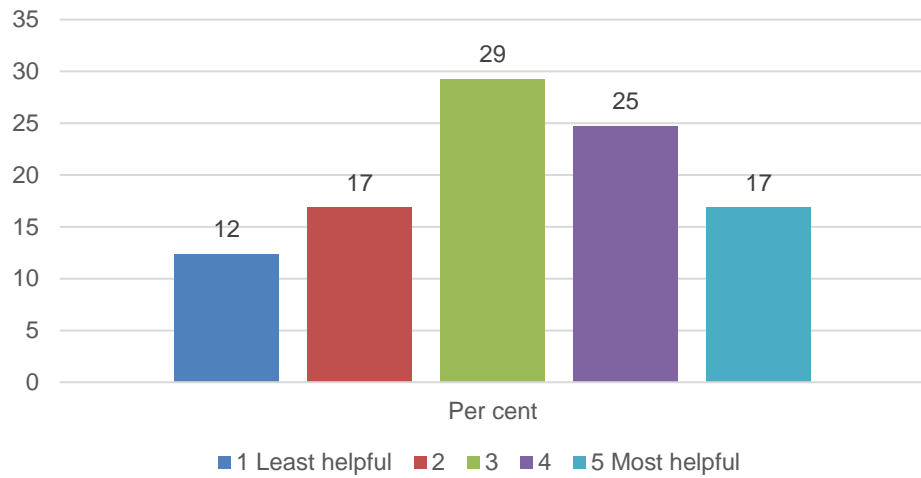
56 per cent of respondents gave “report cards” a 4 or a 5.

Report Cards



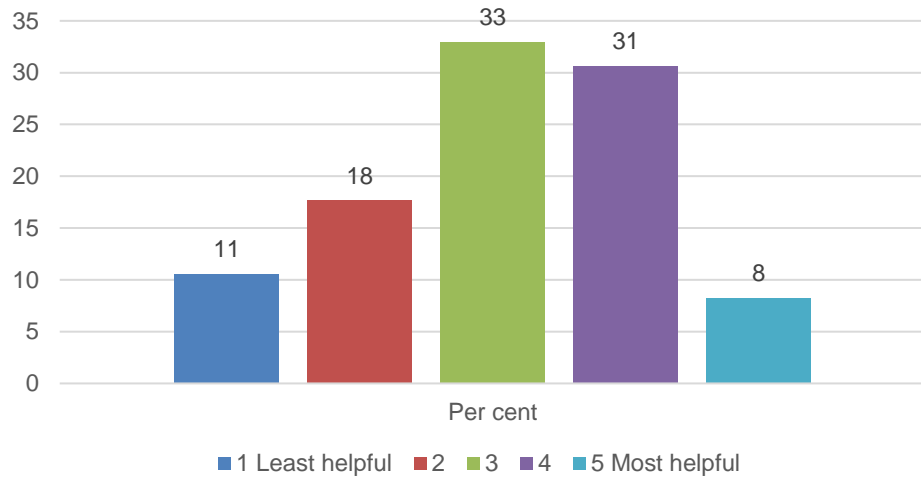
42 per cent of respondents gave “meet the teacher nights” a 4 or a 5.

Meet the teacher nights



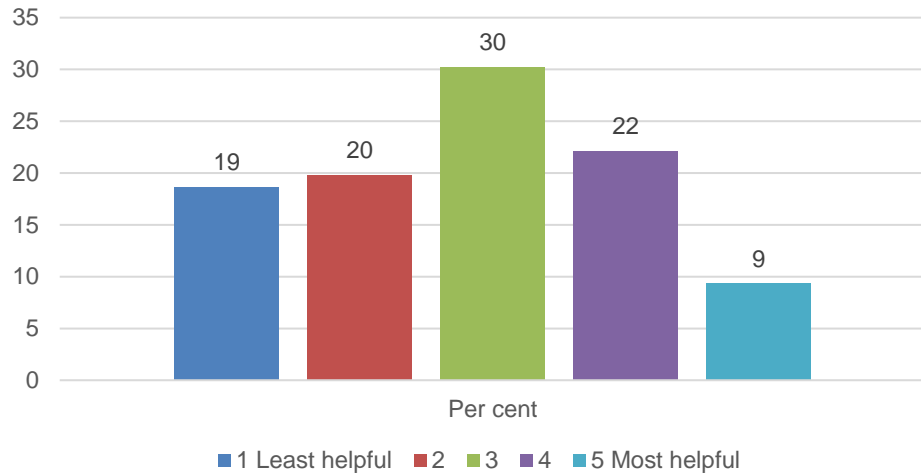
39 per cent of respondents gave “celebrations of learning” a 4 or a 5.

Celebrations of learning



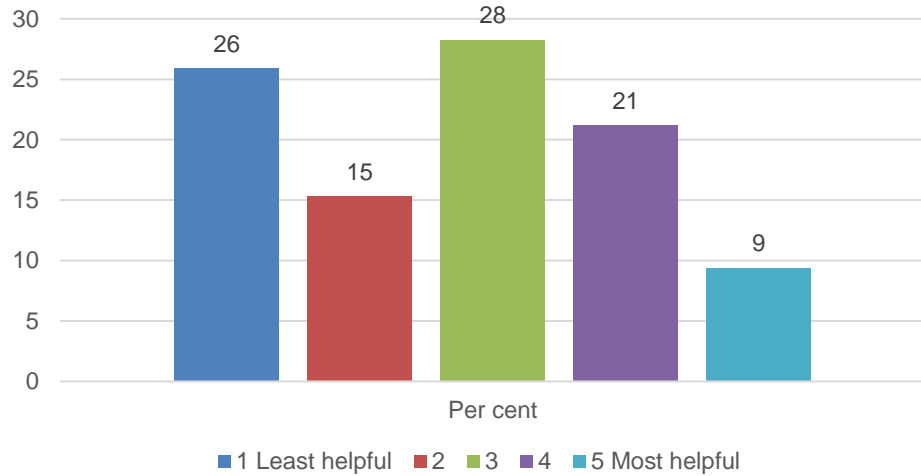
31 per cent of respondents gave “online tools” a 4 or a 5.

Online tools (Iris, PowerSchool, D2L)



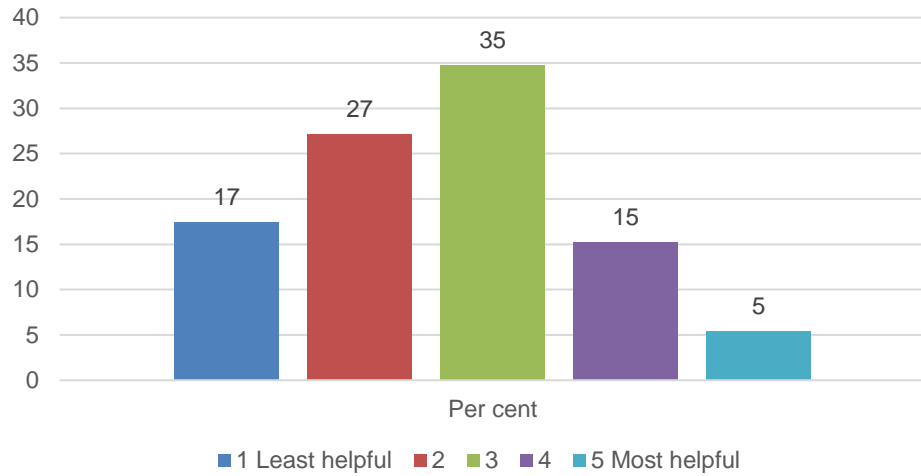
30 per cent of respondents gave “video clips with classroom/student examples” a 4 or a 5.

Video clips with classroom/student examples



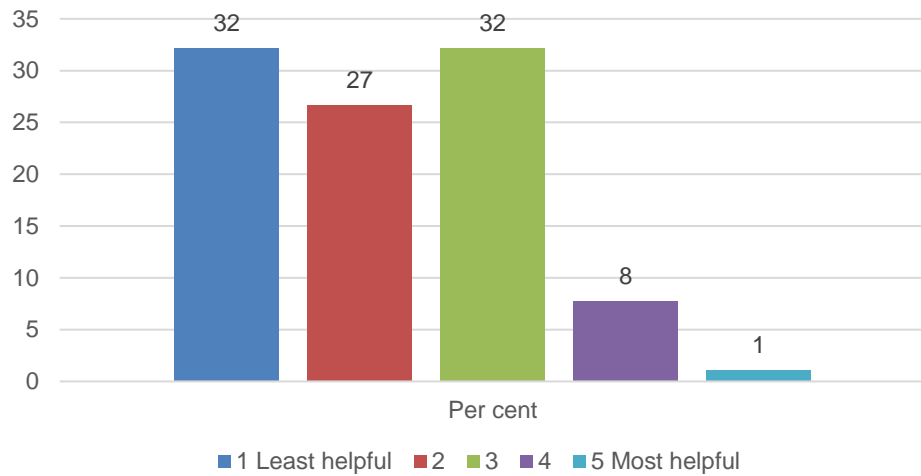
20 per cent of respondents gave “school council presentations” a 4 or a 5.
