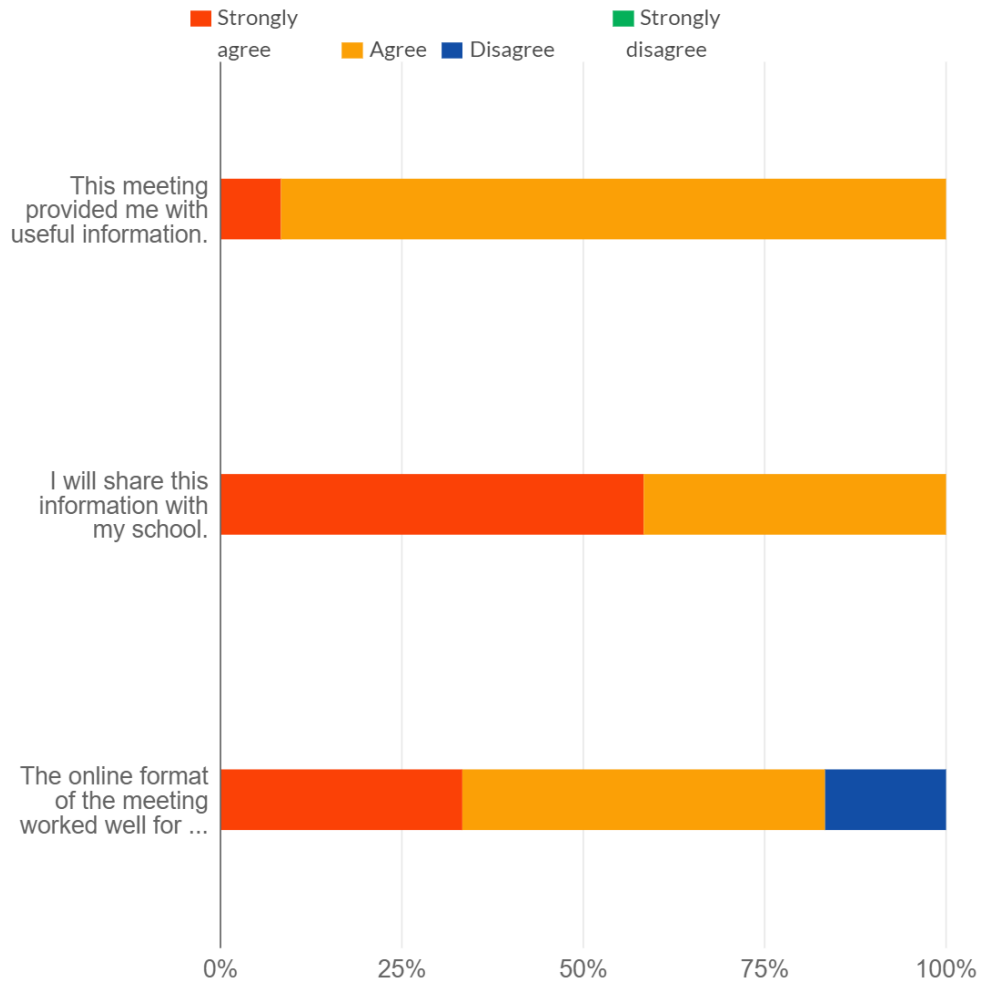


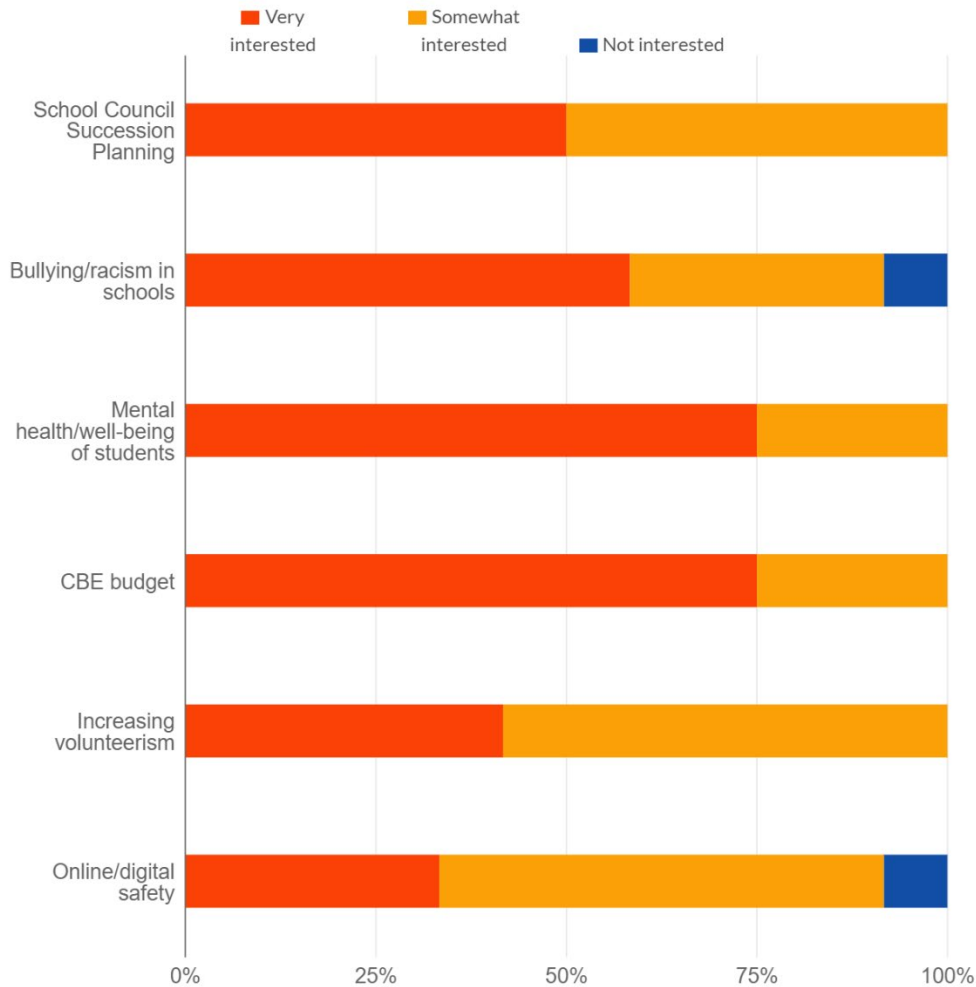
COSC Oct. 22, 2020 Meeting Evaluation
