# AB Ed. Parent Survey Deadlines Approaching

Each year in January, Alberta Education sends an important survey to all parents and guardians of students in Grades 4, 7 and 10. In schools with fewer than 120 students, surveys are sent to parents/guardians of all students. The survey is called the Accountability Pillar Survey. The survey must be mailed by Friday, Feb. 22 or completed online by Friday, Mar. 8, 2019.

Your voice matters. It is very important that parents/guardians complete the survey and return it to Alberta Education. Alberta Education uses the results to assess satisfaction with the quality of education in our schools, and we at the CBE use the information to improve teaching and learning for all our children.
