Municipal Election Nominations Open

The nomination period is now open for candidates wishing to run for the offices of mayor, councillor and school board trustee in the Oct. 18, 2021 municipal election.

Changes have been made to [ward boundaries](#) that take effect for this General Election. Your ward may be different than your current ward. More information about the 2021 Municipal Election, including who is running and how to find your ward, is available on the [City of Calgary website](#).

Should You Run to be a Trustee?

On Oct. 18, 2021 the citizens of Calgary will have their voices heard in our civic election. This includes voting for trustees.

Have you ever considered running? The education of children is the most important responsibility of any society, and the job of trustee plays an important role.

The Board of Trustees provides leadership for the CBE by defining the vision, [Results](#) and Operational Expectations for the organization on behalf of its community.

The Board's job is to represent, lead and serve Calgarians and to govern the CBE. This is done by establishing expectations for organizational results and quality operational performance and then monitoring actual performance against those expectations. This monitoring takes place at public board meetings.

If this sounds like something you're interested in doing, there are a few statutory requirements for this position. You must be a Canadian citizen who is at least 18 years old and has resided in Calgary for the six months prior to nomination.

You will also have to file nomination papers no later than noon on Sept. 20, 2021. On them, you will need the signatures of at least 25 electors who reside in your wards, and give a deposit of \$100.
