#### Bill 1: An Act to Reduce School Fees

- Government is providing additional funding to help reduce fees.
- Fees cannot be increased above current fee amounts
- Similar service levels must be maintained
- Based on Bill 1 funding, some students are eligible for transportation at no cost and others will pay a fee
- Differences based on designated community school or program of choice
- Differences based on distance from community school
- Government considering more changes to fees in 2018-19.

#### **Our reality**

- We have maintained, reduced or eliminated transportation fees for the majority of families
- We continue to advance our long term transportation strategy (plans outlined in June 22, 2016 parent letter)
  - Ensuring students come first
  - Balancing service levels and fees
  - Closing the financial gap
- We are committed to transportation we can all afford and keeping money in the classroom
- We are supportive of Bill 1 and making life more affordable for families

#### Service Level and Fees

Students	Service Level	Fee
Calgary Transit (GR 6-12)	Access existing Calgary Transit stop Additional students will be transitioned from yellow school bus service to Calgary Transit	Eligible = \$151 (after CBE rebate) Non-eligible = \$700

#### Becoming financially sustainable

Factor	Savings
Bell time changes	\$3.5M
Congregated Stops/Low Ridership	\$2.0M
Move more students to Calgary Transit	\$1.7M
Routing efficiencies (partnering)	\$0.9M
Accommodation changes (impacted schools and phase in/out)	\$2.2M
Fewer riders to waive (yellow)	\$0.5M
Total	\$10.8M

\* Factors are interrelated. Changes to one factor will affect savings related to other factors.

#### Becoming financially sustainable

 Together these changes of more than \$10M allow us to deliver a reasonable transportation service we can all afford

### **Changes to Bell Times**

- We know bell time changes will impact families
- Changes will allow buses to run 2-3 routes
- In 2017-18
  - Bell time changes up to 30 minutes
  - Some schools to now have an early dismissal day
- In 2018-19, bell time changes of more than 30 minutes

#### **Important Dates to Remember**

- May 30 principals will communicate detailed school schedules to families.
- June 5 transportation pre-registration deadline (required to complete to have transportation for September 2017).
- **August 10** modified calendar school routes posted.
- **August 30** traditional calendar school routes posted.
