frequently asked questions

How much do the sessions cost?

There is no cost to families.

I don't drive, or sometimes don't have a car. How can I get to the sessions?

We can provide a taxi for you and your family. Please let us know when you register that you require transportation. We will pay for the taxi when you arrive at the school, and provide you with a taxi voucher for your trip home.

Do I bring my child?

Our sessions are interactive and we encourage you to participate with your child. During presentations, facilitators provide childcare. This gives you an opportunity to listen, learn, and ask questions with fewer distractions.

I have other children, can I bring them?

Yes, these sessions are for your entire family. Siblings are welcome to attend all sessions. Please let us know how many children you are planning to bring when you register. If you have family members or friends who spend a lot of time with your child, please invite them to join.

Are there snacks? Some sessions are during mealtimes.

A light, healthy snack will be provided at each session. A variety of fresh fruits and vegetables, cheese, and crackers are usual choices. If your child has any allergies, please let us know what they are when you register. It is also helpful to remind us when you arrive at a session.

Where are the sessions held?

Most sessions take place in elementary schools. The session may not be at your child's school, but we plan to have sessions at schools that are within driving distance of your neighbourhood.
