

CBE High Schools offer many second languages course pathways. The following information has been compiled to support CBE staff, students and families identify which language courses and pathways are available in which CBE high schools. The information is current as of the 2025-2026 school year.

Note | Since 2018, there is no longer a cap on the number of credits students can earn in second languages towards their Alberta High School Diploma.

High schools and Alternative high school programs not listed in the chart did not report any second language courses.

For the **Alberta Program of Studies**, a school's course offering offerings are represented as follows:

- ✓ – the school offers this language course at the 10, 20, and 30 levels.
- 30 – the school offers this course at the 30 level only.

For **IB Diploma Program** and **AP** studies, the use of a checkmark (✓) indicates that the program is offered by the school.
