Second Language Pathways by High School

CBE High Schools offer many second languages course pathways. The following information has been compiled so as to help CBE staff, students and families identify which language courses and pathways are available in which CBE high schools. The information is current as of the 2022-2023 school year.

High schools and alternative high school programs not listed in the chart did not report any second language courses.

For the **Alberta Program of Studies**, a school's course offering offerings are represented as follows:

- √– the school offers this language course at the 10, 20, and 30 levels.
- 10 the school offers this course at the 10 level only.
- 30 the school offers this course at the 30 level only.

For **IB Diploma Program** and **AP** studies, the use of a checkmark (\checkmark) indicates that the program is offered by the school. Exams are typically written in Grade 12, though in some cases may be written in Grade 11. Program requirements vary. Contact the school for more information.
