



# Diversity & Learning Support Advisors



The Diversity and Learning Support Advisors (DLSAs) offer culturally and linguistically tailored services to support Calgary Board of Education (CBE) staff, culturally and linguistically diverse (CLD) students and their families. The advisors collaborate with schools to recognize and leverage students' strengths, abilities, and diverse learning experiences. By doing so, they help foster a more culturally competent and inclusive learning environment across the CBE.

A referral for a **Diversity and Learning Support Advisor (DLSA)** can be submitted when support is needed for the following:



- Building cultural capacity and inclusive practices within the school
- Assisting students with their integration and success in The Calgary Board of Education (CBE)
- Helping students and families gain knowledge about CBE, its schools, programs, and services
- Engaging with and providing direct services to culturally and linguistically diverse students and families
- Providing mediation and conflict resolution support
- Advising families on the informed consent process
- Offering consultative support to educators and staff
- Encouraging families to become active learning partners with schools
- Infusing diverse perspectives about learning into school practices
- Advocating for equitable access and supports for students
