## Re: Construction update for McKenzie Highlands School

The Calgary Board of Education (CBE) is currently building sixteen new schools across the city, including the new McKenzie Highlands middle school for the community of McKenzie Towne. The project was originally announced by the Provincial Government in February 2014. When the project was put out to construction tender the original responses received by the CBE were unsatisfactory and over budget. Having to resubmit tenders resulted in a delay in the start of construction. The school is currently scheduled to open in January 2017.


The CBE is working diligently with architects, project managers and construction managers to ensure timely completion of each project. Construction schedules may change due to a variety of factors including but not limited to materials supply, weather and permit approvals. We anticipate an update on construction status by the end of February 2016.

We recognize that change can be a challenge for families, particularly when there is uncertainty in timelines. We want to reassure our families that we are committed to working together to keep you informed and updated as new information becomes available.
