Re: New School Open House

In May 2013, the Calgary Board of Education received approval from the Province of Alberta for a new school in the community of Copperfield. The school is anticipated to provide educational programming for elementary school-age students, kindergarten to Grade 4, living in the Copperfield community, in southeast Calgary. The school is scheduled to open in September 2016 and will provide instruction in the Regular Program. Elementary students from Copperfield community are currently designated to Maple Ridge School.

The new elementary school in Copperfield will be built at 8 Copperstone Boulevard, S.E., on the approved CBE school site zoned for educational purposes.

The CBE will oversee the design and build of the new school. The prime consultant and project management team have been appointed. Based on a one storey core school design, with modular classrooms, it is estimated to have a floor area of approximately 4811 square metres and will accommodate up to 600 students. The exterior finishes will be of durable materials (eg. masonry).

The Calgary Board of Education will be holding an Open House on Wednesday, June 18 to give community stakeholders the opportunity to learn more about their new schools in Calgary. The Open House will take place in the CBE Education Centre LINK, located at 1221 8 Street, S.W. There will be no formal presentation, so please feel free to drop in any time between 6:00 and 8:00 p.m. You will be able to view preliminary siting and project development information and ask questions about the facilities. As we are in the early stages of the design and build process, information on enrolment and programing will not be available at this meeting. Further public engagements will be scheduled as the work progresses.

This notice will also be sent to the Board of Trustees, Area Director, City Councillors, and Members of the Legislative Assembly for your community.
