Name selected for new middle school in Evergreen

Marshall Springs School is the name of the new middle school being built in Evergreen. Marshall Springs is a man-made wetland area located in Fish Creek Park, close to Evergreen community. There are many rich learning connections, including learning about water management, environmental stewardship, wetlands, and social, environmental, historical, and physical aspects of the area.

After gathering and evaluating stakeholder input, the school naming committee recommended this name to the Board of Trustees for its approval. The committee was comprised of CBE Trustees, parent and/or community representatives and members of CBE administration.

Marshall Springs School is expected to open in 2016. The grade configuration has not yet been determined, but middle schools generally accommodate Grades 5-9. The school will accommodate 900 students on opening day.
