Reminder Notice Regarding Grade Expansion at Dr. George Stanley School

Dear Parents/Guardians:

The Calgary Board of Education (CBE) would like to remind parents that transportation services from the residential district of Cranston to Nickle School will no longer be provided after June 30, 2017.

In a notice dated August 30, 2016 the CBE informed parents that due to the new school opening in Cranston that all K-9 students could be accommodated in the community for the 2017-2018 school year. At the time the CBE committed to transporting students to Nickle School for the 2016-2017 school year.

If students from Cranston choose to stay at Nickle for the 2017-2018 school year transportation services will not be provided.

Grade configurations at schools that serve Cranston:
