## Notice Regarding Overflow Designation for Evanston Students

Dear Students and Parents/Guardians,

The Calgary Board of Education (CBE) would like to **inform** parents and students that Kenneth D. Taylor School is near capacity and is projected to be over capacity for the 2018-2019 school year. The school will not be able to accommodate all students who live in Evanston.

Effective the 2018-2019 school year, new students who cannot be accommodated in Kenneth D. Taylor School will be overflowed to Cambrian Heights School.

### Will Cambrian Heights School grade configuration change?

No, Cambrian Heights School will remain kindergarten to Grade 6 for students living in the home area and the new subdivisions of Carrington and Livingston. Students from Evanston will be designated to Cambrian Heights School for kindergarten to Grade 4 and they will attend Grade 5-6 at Simon Fraser School.

### How many student from Evanston will attend Cambrian Heights School?

At this point we project up to 150-200 additional students will attend Cambrian Heights School in the next two years.

We will be working closely with your principal, Scott Jeffrey to ensure we understand the perspectives of the school community during this transition.
