The Calgary Board of Education (CBE) would like to share with parents a designation change for Grade 7-9 regular program students living in Cityscape. This change will take effect for the 2018-2019 school year, and it will involve students currently at Rundle School in Grade 6 and Dr. Gordon Higgins School in Grade 7.

For the 2018-2019 school year Grades 7 and 8 students from Cityscape will be redesignated to Bob Edwards School. Bob Edwards School is located at 4424 Marlborough Dr. NE in the community of Marlborough. Please note that Bob Edwards School is on a modified calendar similar to Rundle School. Cityscape students who are currently attending Dr. Higgins School in Grade 8 will be able to remain at Dr. Higgins School until the end of Grade 9 or move to Bob Edwards for Grade 9.

Current Grade 5 students attending Rundle School, with a sibling who will move to Bob Edwards, may also attend Bob Edwards School and remain for the grade configuration of the school.

New families to Cityscape who have students in Grade 7 to 9 will be designated to Bob Edwards School.

If you want to learn more about these changes and what they mean for your family, you are invited to attend a meeting on Wednesday, March 14 at 6:30 PM at Rundle School located at 4120 Rundlehorn Dr. NE. The Principals of Rundle, Dr. Gordon Higgins and Bob Edwards Schools as well as the Area 4 Director and System Principal and staff from the CBE Planning & Transportation department will be at the meeting to provide information and answer questions.
