Parents/Guardians:

The Calgary Board of Education (CBE) would like to remind parents that the Deaf and Hard of Hearing (DHH) program will be moving to Jennie Elliott School for the 2018-2019 school year.

The reasons Jennie Elliott School was selected are:

- Space will be available.
- The location is reasonably close to Queen Elizabeth High School where students of the DHH Program in Grades 1–6 move for Grades 7–12.
- Jennie Elliott School has the closed classroom spaces the program requires.
- The opportunity to have students join a school community with hearing peers is important and beneficial for all students.

Currently the students of the DHH Program in Grades 1–6 attend Queen Elizabeth and Stanley Jones schools. The caring and inclusive culture at Jennie Elliott School will provide continuity of support and a smooth transition for students, and for the families and teachers of these students.
