Notice Regarding Regular Program School Designation for Students Residing in Belmont and Yorkville

Dear Students and Parents/Guardians,

Belmont and Yorkville are two new and developing communities located in south Calgary. CBE has received approval from the Minister of Education to add these two communities into our boundary starting in the 2019/2020 school year.

The community of Belmont is located in the South Planning sector of the City; south of 194 Ave SE and west of Macleod Trail SE (see map on the back of this notice). The Belmont community is planned for a population of 7,200 to 7,600 people and will be built out over the next 15 to 20 years.

The community of Yorkville is located in the South Planning sector of the City; south of 194 Ave SW and west of Sheriff King Street S (see map on the back of this notice). The Yorkville community is planned for a population of 9,400 to 10,000 people and will be built out over the next 15 to 20 years.

The Calgary Board of Education (CBE) would like to advise of the following school designations for students residing in the communities of Belmont and Yorkville.

Information Regarding Transportation Services for Regular Programs

New communities are regularly assessed for their suitability for transportation services. We ensure there is a consistent and safe path that is clear of obstructions which are frequently caused by construction supplies and equipment in newer communities. We need city maintained roads for the yellow school bus to enter, maneuver to pick up students and safely exit the community. Next, we look for an appropriate place for a bus stop that will allow for consistent safe loading and unloading of passengers. Once there is a safe path and a safe stop location, we add yellow school bus service to new communities.

Until yellow school bus service is added to new communities, we provide a stop as close as possible in a neighbouring community. The initial bus stop location may not fall within the current CBE guidelines for travel distance to a bus stop. We encourage families to look at routes available on our website [Bus Maps & Schedules](#) to find the current closest stop. Stops and services are reviewed as conditions change in a new community. Information Regarding Transportation Services for Alternative Programs

Where students are not attending their designated regular program school, congregated bus stops may be in place when there are too few students to send a yellow bus in to a community and still meet our fiscal responsibility to reduce busing costs. This CBE guideline applies to all communities not only new communities. Congregated stops may not be within walking distance. Rather, they are a gathering point for students in nearby communities from which the number of riders are very low. Parents and guardians may have to make alternate arrangements to get to the bus stop or school in these cases. We encourage families to look at the current bus routes for the program(s) they are considering to find the closest stop before finalizing their decision.
