Dear Parents/Guardians,

The Calgary Board of Education (CBE) is scheduled to open a second elementary school for the community of Auburn Bay during the 2022-23 school year. The opening of the new elementary school in Auburn Bay will have an impact on grade configurations and attendance areas for Auburn Bay and Seton families.

After careful consideration of the questions and comments we received at the virtual sessions, ideas board, as well as at the Area Office, a decision has been made to move forward with the following accommodation plan starting September 2022:

- New school attendance area for Auburn Bay School and the new elementary school in Auburn Bay (see maps)
- K-4 regular program grade configuration at both elementary schools for 2022-23 school year
- K-5 grade re-configuration at both elementary schools for 2023-24 school year and beyond
- Grades 5-9 grade configuration at the new Auburn Bay middle school for the 2022-23 school year, and Grades 6-9 for the 2023-24 school year and beyond
- K-5 students residing in the community of Seton will be re-designated to Cranston School

We believe this plan provides the best opportunity for the following CBE planning principles to be achieved:

- Students attend school closer to home.
- Program continuity from kindergarten to Grade 12.
- Equitable access for all students to quality learning environments and choice of programs.
- Space and resources are used effectively.

Planning principles are considered in making all CBE student accommodation decisions, and can be found in [AR1090](#).

#### **Who will be impacted by these changes?**

K-3 students living in the boundary for the new elementary school in Auburn Bay (see maps).

- Students currently K to Grade 3 at Auburn Bay School will move to the new elementary school if they live within the attendance area for the new school.

Students attending Andrew Sibbald School:

- Students living in Auburn Bay attending Andrew Sibbald will return to Auburn Bay schools. Transportation services from the Auburn Bay community to Andrew Sibbald School will end June 30, 2022.

Students residing in the community of Seton:

- Seton students currently attending Auburn Bay School may remain at Auburn Bay School if they wish, however, transportation will not be provided. Transportation services from the Seton community to Auburn Bay School will end June 30, 2022.
- If you chose to remain at Auburn Bay School, please contact the principal, otherwise your student will be transferred to Cranston School through this process.

The grade designations changes for each school in Auburn Bay will be implemented as follows:

**Will students need to register at the new school location?**

There is no need to register. Students who are re-designated will automatically be designated to their new school.

New kindergarten students will need to register for their new school. Online registration for the 2022-2023 school year begins Jan. 17, 2022. To register for Kindergarten, please review the information on our [Registration page](#) and follow the instructions.

If students will be designated to a different school and would like to transfer from an alternative program or out of attendance area school, they will need to inform their current school and submit a Transfer Request Form. For more information, please visit: [Transferring between CBE Schools](#).

**Who is the new school Principal?**

Principals for the new schools will be announced in Spring 2022. The principal will work with the existing and new school community, parents and students to develop a school opening plan.

**How will students get to school?**

No busing is anticipated for the elementary schools in Auburn Bay community starting September 2022. Walk zones for the schools will be determined this spring and posted on CBE [Find a School tool](#).

**What support will families and students receive during the transition?**

Each school may provide support in different ways, such as hosting an information session, offering a school tour or other means of communication. Your school will provide information regarding these opportunities once they are determined.

When a student with complex learning needs moves from one school to another, the supports required to fulfill the IPP requirements move with them. Teachers and staff at the former and new school will collaborate to ensure the student’s needs are met.

We expect that students currently in Grade 3 at Auburn Bay School will move to the new elementary school if they live within the attendance area for the new school. This allows students two years in the new school before moving to middle school in 2025. We do anticipate that all newly designated students will move, however, we do recognize that there can be unique learning circumstances that require a conversation between the families, principal and Education Director for the school.

**What about bell times, school calendars, transfer of resources and fundraising dollars, and other decisions?**

School administration will communicate any potential changes with parents, students and staff throughout the implementation process. Any changes will balance the best interest for the school community and CBE. The CBE Administrative Regulations and other requirements and efficiencies will also be considered in these decisions. Check your school website and newsletter regularly for updates.

**What happens if the new school isn’t ready to open on time?**

The CBE is closely monitoring construction progress on all schools anticipated to open for September 2022. If there is a delay, a contingency plan will be communicated to parents. Our contingency plans will ensure the learning needs of students are met. We will keep parents and the community informed of any changes to the expected opening of the new elementary school in Auburn Bay.
