## Notice Regarding Overflow School Designation for Grade 10 to 12 Students Designated to Sir Winston Churchill.

Dear Parents/Guardians,

The Calgary Board of Education (CBE) would like to inform parents and students that due to the continued enrolment growth at Sir Winston Churchill High School, the school will not be able to accommodate all students who reside in the school boundary for the 2022-23 school year.

### No changes for current students or those already registered at Sir Winston Churchill High School

Students currently attending Sir Winston Churchill High School and students already registered to attend for the 2022-23 school year will remain at Sir Winston Churchill High School for the 2022-23 school year, provided they do not move out of the community.

### New registrations will be re-designated to Robert Thirsk High School

As of August 29, 2022, **all new registrations** for Grade 10-12 regular program students designated to Sir Winston Churchill High School for the 2022-23 school year will be re-designated to [Robert Thirsk High School](#).

Eligible students who cannot attend Sir Winston Churchill High School will be placed on a waitlist and called back to the school if space becomes available. Students will only be placed on a waitlist if they are attending their designated overflow school (Robert Thirsk High School).

Registrations for the International Baccalaureate program are also closed for the 2022-2023 school year.

### Why is this change happening?

Following the re-designation of communities to Sir Winston Churchill High School through the high school engagement process, enrolment at Sir Winston Churchill High School continues to grow. While the school has organized its learning environment to support student learning and success, it would be challenging to provide optimal student learning opportunities with the continued growth in enrolment.

We have explored several options in consideration of this decision. However, space is limited and we must sustain the current enrollment level in order to maintain a safe and robust learning environment.

This decision is only for the 2022-23 school year. We will be looking at options for a longer-term solution to this challenge and we will be sharing more information this fall.

**How does a waitlist work?**

If space becomes available in Sir Winston Churchill High School throughout the school year, that space will be offered to students on the waitlist who are currently attending their overflow location (Robert Thirsk High School).

**Will transportation be provided for students attending Robert Thirsk High School?**

High school students are assigned to Calgary Transit as their mode of transportation. Routes can be accessed at [www.calgarytransit.com](http://www.calgarytransit.com) through the “Plan a Trip” tool. While CBE works collaboratively with Calgary Transit, decisions on service levels are made by Calgary Transit based on available space and resources.
