#### Issue

- Enrolment in Juno Beach Academy of Canadian Studies has been steadily declining since its peak in 2008
- As of September 2016 there were 15 students enrolled with no students in Grades 7, 8, or 9

#### Attendance Area

- Single site program
- Attendance area for Juno Beach Academy of Canadian Studies is the City of Calgary
- Minimal impacts if students choose to continue at Lord Beaverbrook High School or return to their designated schools

#### **Enrolment and Transportation Impacts**

- Students can choose to return to their designated high school without enrolment implications to the school
- Students may also attend Lord Beaverbrook High School as Out of Attendance Area students
- High school students across the City access Calgary Transit for transport to and from school

# Programming and Educational Impacts of Closing for Students

- Greater access to courses/programming with wider array of course options
- Familiarity with Lord Beaverbrook High School campus
- Larger numbers of students per class enhances learning opportunities
- Greater extra-curricular opportunities available to students

# Programming and Educational Impacts of Closing for Other Schools

Students re-designated to community school

# Programming and Educational Impacts of Remaining Open

- Principles of programming are not being met
- Limited ability to offer core component courses required for program integrity
- Programming would not be offered to Grades 7-10 students

### Financial Implications of Remaining Open

Scenario	Staff Costs	Facility Costs
If program was to remain open	\$425,000	\$200,000

## Financial Implications of Closing

Scenario	System Cost Savings	Facility Costs
If program were to close	\$175,000	\$200,000

### Future Use of Facility

- Contingency space to support modernization of other CBE facilities
- Possible CBE administrative use
- Returning Complex Learning Needs Grade 12 students at Dr. Norman Bethune School
